REGULATIONS (INDIVIDUAL)

The competitions will be held in accordance with the Sport and Organization Rules and the Refereeing Rules of the International Judo Federation (IJF)

1 - WEIGHT CATEGORIES

MEN

Extra light weight	up to and including 60 Kg	(-60 Kg)
Half light weight	over 60 Kg up to and including 66 Kg	(-66 Kg)
Light weight	over 66 Kg up to and including 73 Kg	(-73 Kg)
Half middle weight	over 73 Kg up to and including 81 Kg	(-81 Kg)
Middle weight	over 81 Kg up to and including 90 Kg	(-90 Kg)
Half heavy weight	over 90 Kg up to and including 100 Kg	(-100 Kg)
Heavy weight	over 100 Kg	(+ 100 Kg)

WOMEN

Extra light weight	up to and including 48 Kg	(-48 Kg)

2 - ENTRIES

The number of entries permitted is limited:

- 2.1 Each National Federation may enter TWO (2) competitors in each of the weight categories, i.e. a total of 28 (14 weight categories each for men and women).
- 2.2 Three participants from three different countries must compete in a category in order that the championship for that category to be held.
- 2.3 Competitors may only be entered in the weight category to which they belong.
- 2.4 A participant can only be entered in one weight category.
- 2.5 Only the names of the competitors duly entered following the above procedure will be drawn.

3 - NATIONALITY

Competitors must be of the same nationality as the National Federation, which has entered them. Proof of nationality will be required according to the Sport and Organization Rules of the IJF.

4 - COMPETITORS' AGE

The minimum age limit for competitors is 15 years, born in the year 1996 and before.

For those competitors who have not attained their majority (legal adult age), the National Federations should obtain authority from their parents or legal guardians.

5 - WEIGH-IN

The weigh-in will be carried out in accordance with the Sport and Organization Rules of the IJF.

The weigh-in will be conducted on the same day that each respective category is being contested.

The competitors shall weigh-in wearing only gymnastic underclothing or naked, under the supervision of a weigh-in official of the same gender; the competitors may be requested to remove their underclothing to ensure they are within the prescribed limits of the weight category in which they are entered.

Only one weight control shall be permitted to each competitor up on the scale during the official weigh-in period. No tolerance shall be allowed either above or below the weight category.

5.1 The weigh-in will be under the control of the Sports and Refereeing Commissions.

5.2 Each competitor will bring to the weigh-in his or her IJF accreditation card



6 - JUDOGI CONTROL

6.1 Approved judogi:

Competitors should wear an IJF approved judogi supplied by one of the following manufacturers: Greenhill, SFJAM NORIS, MIZUNO, Double D Adidas, HAYAKAWA, Fighting Film, Budo Sport AG, ESSIMO, MATSURI B.V.

6.2 Judogi Control:

It will be operated with a sokuteiki by IJF Education Commission.

Judogi must have Tag with its Official Label with an optical code provided by IJF which cannot be falsified. One IJF Official Stick on Jacket, one on Trousers and one on Belt.

6.3 Backnumber

Each competitor is obliged to have sewn on the back of his judogi a backnumber bearing his surname and his National Olympic Committee abbreviation. The backnumber can be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com

The delivery can take up to 4 weeks.

6.4 Advertising

Competitors should carry on the back of their jacket the IJF dedicated sponsor of the event. Advertising on the judogi must be in compliance with the IJF rules.

6.5 National Emblem

Athletes can have their national emblem on the left front part of the jacket within a space of 100cm².

N.B It is the responsibility of the judoka to comply with the IJF regulation rules.

7. DRAW

7.1 The draw will be conducted in accordance with the Sport and Organization Rules of the IJF. It will be held on Monday, August 22nd, 2011 at 14h00, in the "City Hall" under the control and auspices of the I.J.F Sports Commission.

7.2 Each National Federation must send a delegate to attend the draw; a maximum of two delegates per National Federation will be authorized and minimum one should attend the draw.

Delegates attending the draw should comply with the IJF Dress Code rule.

After the completion of the draw, two sets of the draw lists will be provided to each delegation.

7.3 The top eight (8) among the entered competitors in each weight category will be seeded according to the World Ranking List.

8 - REFEREEING

The new rules for the period from 1/01/2010 to 31/12/2012 are applied.

8.1 The Refereeing Commission will select the referees for each contest.

8.2 Refereeing will be conducted by IJF International referees in accordance with the Refereeing Rules of the IJF.

8.3 For each contest there will be three referees of nationalities different from those of the competitors. One (1) Referee and two (2) Judges at opposite corners will conduct the contest.

The "Care System" with two (2) cameras filming the contest at two (2) different opposite angles will be set up to help the referees.

Control and supervision of the "Care System" will be done by the IJF Refereeing Commission.



8.4 Referees in case of any difficulties can consult the Refereeing Commission Members. Under no circumstances can competitors or their representatives consult the referees or the Refereeing Commission. Competitors or their representatives have no right to appeal the decisions, and any attempt to approach the Organizing Committee or the IJF Executive Committee in this regard, could result in their suspension or exclusion from the Championships.

9 - CONTROL OF THE RIGHT TO COMPETE

The control (based on the Sport and Organization Rules of the IJF) will include: **NATIONALITY OF COMPETITORS**

Proof of identity, will be established by production of a passport or an official document or its copy from the country for which the competitor has been entered, and the IJF accreditation card will be issued to each competitor. If a competitor has more than one nationality, such competitor can only represent one country and thereafter may not represent any other country, until after a period of three (3) years has elapsed. If the two concerned federations desire, they can ask the IJF to reduce or even to suppress this delay in conformity with the Sport and Organization Rules of the IJF and the Olympic Chart, point 42.

Only maximum 2 representatives by National Federation must be personally present and submit for all competitors their identity documents (passport or official identity card).

10 - INSURANCE

Each National Federation is responsible for his/her competitor (s), [the control of non pregnancy as well as gender control, is placed under the responsibility of the National Federation], and must assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as the civil liabilities for their competitors and officials. The IJF has no liability for any claims of illness, injury or death.

11 – DURATION OF CONTESTS

MEN & WOMEN: Five (5) minutes (real time). The “Golden score” shall be three (3) minutes.

12 – SYSTEM OF COMPETITION

Further to International Judo Federation Executive Committee, the following system of competition will be used during the 28th World Judo Championships:

An elimination system with repechage starting at the quarter-final (last 8), i.e. for all categories the competitors will be divided into two tables by means of a “draw”, and an elimination system will be used to produce two finalists.

The competitors defeated in the quarter-final will compete in two repechage contests:

- The winners of each of this two repechage contests will compete in Bronze medal contests against the loser of the semifinal contest of the respective opposite table.
- The winners (2) of those contests are placed third;
The losers (2) are placed fifth;
- The losers (2) of repechage contests are placed seventh.

13 - PARTICULAR RULES FOR WOMEN

Female contestants shall wear under the jacket either, a plain white or off-white tee shirt, with short sleeves, rather strong, long enough to be worn inside the trousers, or a plain white or off-white leotard with short sleeves.

All other regulations must be adhered to.

14 - CODE OF CONDUCT FOR COACHES

The code of conduct for coaches will be strictly observed. See the Annex of Sport and Organization Rules of the IJF.



15 - ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

The anti-doping control will include in each category:

15.1 The winner of the category

15.2 One of the three other medal winners,

15.3 One of the 5th and 7th placed competitors

As per draw (for 15.2 & 15.3) carried out in accordance with the Anti-doping Rules and the Sport and Organization Rules of the IJF; according to the introduction of the new repechage system additional information will be provided regarding the point 14.3.

- The competitors drawn among the fifth and seventh have to go immediately to the anti-doping control.

- At the end of the medal ceremony, competitors summoned in writing by the Physician mandated by the IJF follow the indications leading them to the Doping Control Station (DCS). They have to report to the DCS within 60 minutes after they have signed the Summons. They are constantly accompanied by chaperons from the organization from the time they receive their notice until they reach the DCS.

A person of their choice (team doctor, coach, trainer, delegation head...) may accompany the competitors. The draw is made during the competition before the start of the finals block.

16 – AWARDS

The organizer shall provide for presentation:

16.1 A certificate of participation for each participant.

16.2 Medals and diploma: First place: Gold medal and diploma

Second place: Silver medal and diploma

Two Third places: Bronze medals and diplomas

16.3 Diplomas Two fifth places: diplomas

Two Seventh places: diplomas

17 - PAYMENT OF FEES BY PARTICIPATING COUNTRIES

National Federations which have not paid their fees to the IJF by the required date will automatically be suspended from all activities of the IJF, including participation in the Championships, until full payment is made of all accounts due.

National Federation will have to pay an entry fee of one hundred (100) US Dollars for each weight category before the 22nd of July 2011 to the IJF General Treasurer at:

REGULATIONS (TEAM)

1. TEAMS

There will be 16 teams competing in the men's competition and 16 teams in the women's competition.

- 2 teams = 2 finalists from African Team Championships 2011
- 4 teams = 4 medalists from Asian Team Championships 2011
- 4 teams = 4 medalists from European Team Championships 2011
- 2 teams = 2 finalists from Pan American Team Championships 2011
- 1 team = winner of Oceania Team Championships 2011
- 1 team for organizing country / France
- 1 extra team from the continent of last winner
(Asia for men category and Europe for women category)
- 1 team as IJF Wild Card

Each team will consist of 5 (five) competitors for Men as well as for Women.

Note: the masculine gender used in relation to any physical person shall, unless there is a specific provision to the contrary, be understood as including the feminine gender.

1.1 WEIGHT CATEGORIES

Women

Half Light weight	up to and including 52 Kg
Light weight	over 52 Kg up to and including 57 Kg
Half Middle weight	over 57 Kg up to and including 63 Kg
Middle weight	over 63 Kg up to and including 70 Kg
Heavy weight	over 70 Kg

Men

Half Light weight	up to and including 66Kg
Light weight	over 66 Kg up to and including 73 Kg
Half Middle weight	over 73 Kg up to and including 81 Kg
Middle weight	over 81 Kg up to and including 90 Kg
Heavy weight	over 90 Kg

The team contests will be fought in the above order. Each competitor is entitled to compete in his own weight category or in the next higher category. One reserve is allowed for each weight category. A team has to consist of minimum 4 (four) competitors.

2. CONTROL OF THE RIGHT TO COMPETE

During the control (based on the Sports and Organization Rules), identity and weight category in which the competitors have been entered will be checked.

2.1 NATIONALITY

Competitors must be of the same nationality as the country enters them.

Proof of identity will be established by production of a passport or an official document or its copy from the country for which the competitor has been entered and then the control card will be issued for the competitor. If a competitor has more than one nationality, such competitor can only represent one country and thereafter may not represent any other country, until after a period of three (3) years has elapsed. If the two federations concerned wish so, they can ask the IJF to reduce or even to suppress this delay in conformity with the Sport and Organization Rules of the IJF and the Olympic Chart, point 42.

2.2. AGE

Minimum 15 years of age as defined in SOR



2.3. INSURANCE and CIVIL LIABILITY

Each National Federation is responsible for its competitors (for female competitors, the control of non pregnancy is placed under the responsibility of the National Federations as well the gender control) and must assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as the civil liabilities for their competitors and officials, including the nominated referees, during the event.

3. WEIGH-IN

The weigh-in will be carried out in accordance with the sports and Organization Rules of the IJF, on the same morning as team competition.

4. COMPETITION SYSTEM

The method of competition will be the elimination system with Quarter final repechage.

5. COMPOSITION OF THE TEAMS

Before each round the team leader must present to the Sports Director the compositions of the team. At each round he/she has the right to replace one or several competitors by other(s) competitors of the corresponding weight category or of the next lower category (see point 1). All competitors presented for the team contest at the official bow on the mat have to compete. A competitor, who has presented himself for the contest and does not compete, loses the right to compete in the event. The team can enter another competitor in the same weight category in the next round. If one team does not arrive for a match, the other team will be declared the winner by 5-0.

6. DRAW

- 6.1** The draw will be held on Saturday, 27th August in the competition venue before the final block. The time will be specified at the accreditation.
- 6.2** The seeding will take into consideration the medalists (and if necessary the results) from last Team World Championships 2010. Up to four teams will be seeded.
- 6.3** Teams of the same Union must be separated where possible, taking into consideration the results of Continental Team Championships of same year

7. DURATION OF CONTESTS

Each contest will be of 5 minutes for both Women and Men Events (real time) and Golden Score contest will be of 3 minutes.

8. JUDOGI CONTROL

The Judogi control will be under the supervision of the IJF. The same provisions will apply as for the individual World Judo Championships – see the Regulations.

9. REFEREEING RULES

Refereeing will be conducted by IJF International referees in accordance with the Refereeing Rules of the IJF. The same provisions will apply as for the individual World Judo Championships – see the Regulations.

10. DECISION

If at the end of the contest there is not at least a difference of a Yuko between the two competitors, the contest will continue according to Golden Score rule. The referees must take an obligatory decision in each contest.

The number of contests won will decide the winning team.



11. ANTIDOPING CONTROL

The Anti-Doping-Control will take place after the awarding ceremony. From each medal winner team two competitors, having participated in the last contest, determined by draw, will be submitted to the control.

12. INSCRIPTION FEES

An inscription fee of 700 USD per team has to be paid during the IJF Accreditation (Control of Nations Sunday 21st and Monday 22nd August 2011) at the desk of IJF General Treasury.

Payments can be done in Euros and American dollars to the IJF.

After the Control of Nations, under no condition shall refunds be given.

14. AWARDS

The organizer shall provide for presentation:

First place - 1 trophée - 12 gold medals, flowers and gifts

Second place - 1 trophée - 12 silver medals, flowers and gifts

All National Federations, officials, trainers and athletes participating in the 28th WJC have to respect and accept the authority of the IJF officials, the Statutes, the Sports and Organization Rules and the Refereeing Rules of the International Judo Federation related to the World Championships. According to the IJF Rules and SOR Provisions (point 23.8), individuals deemed to have acted against the IJF, its principles or purposes shall be subject to suspension or expulsion from the 28th WJC and/or cancellation of their accreditation cards.

18. ATTENTION VERY IMPORTANT

According to SOR article 13.3.5, each National Federation has to bring for the award ceremony its official national anthem (short version) recorded on CD, CD-Rom or DVD, as well as two official national flags for hanging (1.20m x 1.80m).

The competitors wearing their judogi will stand behind the podium according to the following order 2,1,3,3. Every competitor having won a medal has to attend the ceremony and receive his medal in person. If a competitor is absent during the awarding ceremony for no valid reasons he will lose the right for the medal. It is strictly forbidden for competitors on the podium to bring national flags or the similar identification other than the one represented in the regular manner on their equipment. Any demonstration of religious, political, personal or commercial sign is prohibited and so is wearing a cap or any other head cover.
