History:

This park was dedicated in February of 2003. The area was formally part of Old City Hall Park. The dedication resulted after the Alaska Native Center approached the Municipality asking to name something in honor of Elizabeth & Roy Peratrovich. They were a Tlingit couple who worked hard for equal rights for native Alaskans. The committee felt they should be honored in a place visible to many who live and travel here. Elizabeth & Roy worked hard to get the anti discrimination law passed in 1945 so all native people would have the same rights as others already enjoyed. Forty years after this was passed the governor signed a bill to make February 16th Elizabeth Peratrovich Day.
