STREET LIFE GETS EURO-SUPPORT

PolyGram Lines Up Extensive TV Campaign

PolyGram companies throughout Europe are supporting the release of Street Life, the double album of 20 of the biggest hits from the Bryan Ferry/Roxy Music catalogue, to the tune of more than £750,000.

Each territory is committed to campaigns taking in tv/radio advertising, print advertising and in-store display and merchandising. Germany, for instance, is spending some £100,000 on radio advertising alone.

Pan-European television advertising comes on top of the national marketing spends, and started April 21 for five or six weeks. Both Music Box and Sky Channel are running a total of 300 advertising spots aimed to reach over five million homes in 13 countries.

The two channels also feature heavily the video of Bryan Ferry's current single Is Your Love Strong Enough?, plus their own independent one-hour specials.

The Compact Disc version of Street Life is one of the longest-

playing in the CD format, with over 70 minutes playing time.

DUBLIN STAGES MEGA ROCK EVENT

The biggest rock event ever staged in Ireland is set for May 27, in Dublin's RDS venue. Twelve hours of music by Irish artists, headed by U2. Van Morrison, Bob Geldof & The Boomtown Rats, Clannad, Rory Gallagher, Elvis Costello and Chris De Burgh, is to be broadcast live by RTE Television and Radio 2.

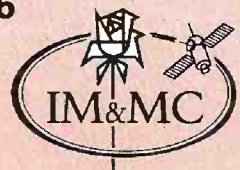
Behind the massive production is Self-Aid, an attempt to deal with the tragic Ireland unemployment situation which has nearly 250,000 people out of work. As with Live-Aid last year, there will be a telethon and pledges will take the form of job offers or money to finance projects to

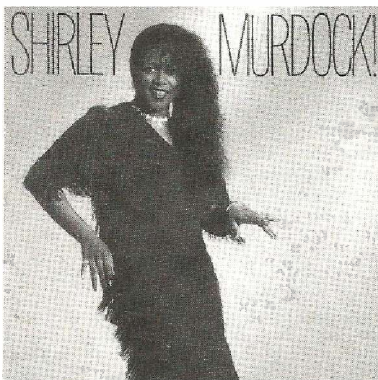

The Willesden Dodgers - 1st Base - Jive

In '83 Clive Colder had the idea of making a hip hop rhythm track LP. It did so well in the States that afterwards a group of Zomba contracted funk-rock producers and engineers joined the team. This 2nd LP is the result. Expectations for it are to sell 250,000 copies in the USA. It's again full of electro beat and at least bound for the dance charts.



Shirley Murdock - Shirley Murdock! - Elektra

Highly danceable and fast synthesizer funk tunes. Shirley has a dry, pinched voice especially great in the lower parts of the gamut. In the higher parts sometimes reminiscent of Michael J. in his Jackson 5 period. Zapp team wrote and produced the album.



SOS Band - Sands Of Time- Tabu

SOS's music is melodious as always but their beat in general has become harder, less smooth. The finest, 1st single of this LP is doing quite well in the UK. (17 for 3rd consecutive week). Production of course by T. Lewis and J. Jam.

Grand Master Funk - Who Messed Up The World (Palladium) Sweden

Master available excl. USA. Contact: Torbjorn Sten at Palladium, tel.8- 540695. A rare thing, a New York rapper debuting on a Swedish label. This record is an electro rhythm rap combining all kinds of noises from things such as a dustbin used as a drum and a plastic squeak doll for babies. Even Reagan's voice is fit in to suggest the answer to the question posed in the title. Great fun.

Fehlmann's Ready Made - Ready Made (Mercury) Germany

Extremely clever mix of various great film music themes like John Berry's Bond-tune and Ennio Morricone's 'Once Upon', all linked and wrapped up in a fashionable dancebeat. A noteworthy instrumental.

Rocky M. - Disco Lady (Arrow/EMI Electrola) Germany

Germany is still being washed over by Modern Talking clones and sound-a-likes (who can blame new talent for trying? all MT's singles went to No. 1). A boy who comes very near is Rocky M.; his soft-sweet voice over this Patrick Cowley-like (131 BPM) could make the Germans go for it.

Gibson Brothers - Party Tonight (Julisa/Carrere) France

The men renowned for mass hits like 'Cuba' and 'Que Sera' are trying to make their comeback. This time their vocal share has been diminished and replaced by females to support the chorus in a carnivalesque sing-a-long.

Candi Mc Kenzie - Turn Me Up (Adventure/WEA) UK

A Swain & Joley production, not at all the stuff we're used to hearing from them. It sometimes reveals similarities with Frank Arian's Eruption. Dark timbered female voice in a floorfilling groove. Already a club fave in Amsterdam.

Wally Badarou - Novela Das Nove (Spider Woman) (4TH & Broadway) UK

A jazzy latin sounding track by black instrumentalist W.B., as "empty" as the previous hitsingle 'Chief Inspector' of which a Precinct 13 version fills the flip. From the Oscar winning movie 'Kiss Of The Spider Woman'.

World's Famous Supreme Team - Hey! D.J. (Charisma/Virgin) UK

A re-release, this cheerful and funky rap which origins from the time they supported Malcolm McClaren back in '83.

Precious Wilson - Jewel Of The Nile (Jive) UK

After Ruby Turner's 'I'm In Love' and Billy Ocean's Eurohot no. 1 'When The Going' this could be the third winning single from the OST Jewel Of The Nile. A moody and exotic uptempo ballad almost breathing an oriental atmosphere. But that might be on purpose.

Centerfold - Dictator (Injection/CNR) Holland

Another (sexy) Dutch female trio with much potential to crossover. This new single is even given airplay on the less commercial stations in their homecountry. Trendy floor filler in a very funky mood that really deserves to do well. Who wouldn't want to get in touch with this kind of Dutch? Dance Mix by Rutger Kroese who usually remixes records of the Star Sisters and Mai Tai (all on the same label). After only two weeks they are already bound for the top 10.

Millie Scott - Prisoner Of Love (Fourth & Broadway) UK

publ. Island Music, tel. 1-8469141. Master owner Island, tel. 1-7411511 Pushy black Hi-NRG backed by sharp brass sections. Millie is a powerful and very experienced vocalist along the lines of Jocelyn Brown, Jenny Burton and Jennifer Holliday. Chart potential in Holland due to its appearance in the official retail tipparade overthere and AVRO's choice to make it record of the week for the necessary airplay.

Ashford and Simpson - Time Talkin' (EMI) UK

publ. Spurs Music Publishing, Master owner EMI tel. 1-4864488 High tempo-ed disco alternated by slower soul breaks from the couple that always perform vivid duets so well. From the forthcoming musical 'Time' (starring a.o. Cliff Richard and Sir Laurence Olivier).

Swan - Don't Talk About It (Memory Records) Italy

publ. Renata/B. Mikulski tel. (Germany) 6436/4052 One of the best Eurobeat 12" of '86 up to now, a smart production containing all the ingredients that make this kind of music so successful. Pop market potential especially for France, Spain and Italy.

David Grant - Close To You (Chrysalis) UK

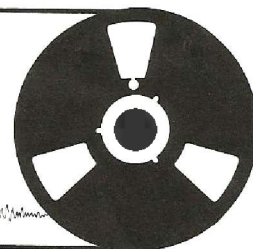

Richard T. Bear - The Runner (LP) (Teldec) Germany

American session-musician who made his first album for RCA in 1977. This is his 5th album and his 2nd for Teldec. A well-balanced set of American pop and ballads. The title track is the most commercial (and common) offering, originally written by Georgio Moroder for Diana Ross. 'New York City' is a romantic piano ballad in the best Billy Joel-tradition. Bear is a good songwriter and his own compositions can easily match the quality of the cover songs.

Bezu et le Grand St. Germain - Ali Baba (Joy-Records) France

French quartet with Monsieur Bezu as the centre. A cheerful ditty that mixes a Boney M-type of production with a bit of oriental flavour and the typical French temperament. With the right type of promotional backing (e.g. appearances in big family shows) this could be the next novelty hit.

Memo - Everybody Loves A Hero (Polydor) Germany

A mainstream Top 40 pop song with an infectious hook and a crisp production by the Anglo-Turkish Memo (Kurt). The song is taken from the conceptual album Anya & Marni. A novel by the same title was published last month as well (also written by Memo). Deserves a European release.

Paris Biz - Black And Blue (Really Blue) (Mekano Records) Sweden

This is very, very good. An intriguing pop single with a slow but definite and forward beat. Enwrapped in a tasteful production, the slightly detached female vocals fare well in this synthesizer backed (blue-eyed) pop composition. A timeless melody and a stylish production, the best product we heard since very long from Sweden. Act now!

Trance Dance - Do The Dance (CBS) Sweden

Infectious percussion-driven pop by a multi-national foursome. Youthful hedonism in a colourful Modern Romance-type of production (done by the son of Motorhead's Lemmy, Paul Inder).

Style - Dover-Calais (Alpha) Sweden
Those Swedish have a penchant for commercial bubble-pop. Although they didn't win the Swedish finals for the Eurovision Songcontest, according to the Swedish youth they deserved so. Easy and comfortable pop that, although not setting the world on fire, could steal the hearts of many in Europe. In two weeks the single climbed up to no. 1 of the Swedish national charts and sales have exceeded platinum.

Chico Hablas - Events (LP) (Mercury) Germany

Musical poetry, composed, arranged and produced by guitarist/keyboard player Chico Hables (even the album design and the beautiful artwork plus the short stories on the back sleeve are by him). Nine instrumental pieces based on and inspired by historical events ('Stanley & Livingstone') and personal experiences and impressions ('Los Voladores'; 'Flight Over Peru'). A very talented musician who translates his stories through an impressive spectrum of acoustic & electric sounds.

Laban - Caught By Surprise (Mega Records) Denmark

Charming mainstream pop tune with Bee Gees-like backing vocals by Danish duo Laban. After 3 local language platinum albums, this is their first English release. A simple and smooth production, ready for cross-over.

Singles Guide

Due to a very unfortunate mistake last week's Airplay Top 50 appeared to be the one of issue 15. Although the information as stated in last week's singles guide was correct with regards to positions etc., the corresponding airplay chart was not the correct one. We hope this has not caused too many inconveniences for those basing their programmes on our compilations.

In the meantime **Madonna** has this week best played single in Europe as *Live To Tell* moves in its 3rd week from 5 to 1 and puts the 5 week chart topper *Absolute Beginners* (the longest airplay topper of this year) back to no. 2. It is Madonna's first airplay topping single since last year's *Into The Groove*.

Peter Gabriel's latest single *Sledgehammer* picked up a considerable amount of airplay this week and many love its soulful leanings; in its 2nd week the single climbs from 19 to 8.

The highest airplay entry has **Sade** with her new single *Never As Good As The First Time*. It is the 3rd single from the Promise album, following earlier hits *Is It A Crime*, that entered at 16 in the Airplay Top 50 the beginning of this year, and *The Sweetest Taboo* (entering at 14 in the Airplay Top 50). Second best entry this week for **Pete Dinklage**, that wicked sinner with his obsession for the popsong in grandiose style. *Sinful!* enters at 34 after good airplay in England and some tips from the Continental correspondents.

Yet another track is released from **Dire Straits'** best selling European album of 1985 *Brother In Arms*, entitled *Your Latest Trick*. If we counted right this is already their 5th from that album (including the CD single *Brothers In Arms*) and the band just broke another record in the English charts by having their album for the 50th consecutive in the Top 10. This has only happened with 8 albums before now.

After the worldwide success of *The Never Ending Story* single **Limahl** comes with his new single in over a year. Entitled *Love In Your Eyes*, it was again produced by Giorgio Moroder and to say it honestly: it is a bit too romantic for our tastes. However, with the unmistakable Moroder stamp it will find its way to the charts very easily.

That wonderful talent **Suzanne Vega** is out

with a new single called *Left Of Center*, probably the best track on the A&M soundtrack *Pretty In Pink*. We hope this single will be picked up by many of you. Also from that same OST comes the new OMD single *If You Leave*. Already a hit in the States and the UK will most likely be next.

The production sound of **Jimmy Jam and Terry Lewis** is firmly entrenched in today's disco/pop charts. Their cool and spare mark can be heard on the latest albums of **Force M.D.'s**, **Janet Jackson**, **Alexander O'Neil** and **Patty Austin**. This in demand team can also be heard on the **S.O.S. Band's** latest single *The Finest*. Already a huge hit in the UK and now also slowly taking off on

the continent as well. Check them out!

If you have room left on your playlist don't forget to add the new singles of **Blancmange** (*I Can See It*), **Diana Ross** (*Experience*) and **Philip Bailey's** latest Nile Rodger's produced *State Of The Heart*.

George Michael has his first European chart topper with *A Different Corner* (*Careless Whisper* stuck at 3 in the Hot 100 october 1984), putting *Absolute Beginners* back to no. 2. *Living Doll* is now at 7 and that is utterly utterly good!

Other moves in the Hot 100 for **Simple Minds** (11-23), **Samantha Fox** (12-22) and **Sam Cooke** (16-45).

HOOK HEAVY WAX

As you may know by now, Wax combines the musical and songwriting skills of Andrew Gold, the Californian singer/songwriter and Graham Gouldman, once of 10 CC and way back involved in the hits of Yardbirds, The Hollies and Herman's Hermits. While their single *Right Between The Eyes* is still waiting to enter the Hot 100, the duo have released their first album, entitled *Magnetic Heaven*, this week. It has become a hook heavy album with an overwhelming amount of catchy songs. The whole of side 1 has hit feel in every groove and we urge you to check out *Hear No Evil*, danceable and full of good moods, *Shadows Of Love* with its E.L.O.-like vocals and hearing *Ball And Chain* over again, it is unbelievable that this powerful pop single failed to make impact last year. We also like *Systematic*, the first track on the B-side. Let's give them a chance.

For those in favour of roots rock 'n' roll we recommend the 2nd album of *The Del-Lords* with their EMI America album *Johnny Comes Marching Home*, an album that we tipped a few weeks back. Operating in the basic setting of guitars, drums and bass, the band impresses most in tracks like *Heaven*, *Love Lies Dying* (Del Fuegos-like) and *Against My Will* with its country leanings. The production of Neil Geraldo (of Pat Benatar's backing band) is immaculate and the band can surely heat up your airwaves.

On her latest album, *Bonnie Tyler* has chosen the epic way. By teaming up with producer Jim Steinman and with the help of musicians like Roy Bittan and Max Weinberg (of E-Street Band fame) the album gets a full blown production sound and that coupled with her thrilling voice makes this a

worthwhile listening experience. Including the hits *If You Were A Woman*, *Loving You's A Dirty Job* and *Holding Out For A Hero*, it further contains hit potentials like the Jim Steinman penned *Ravishing* and the R&B classic *Band Of Gold*.

Raised on Radio is the 11th album of the American rock band *Journey*. The band is now trimmed down to a trio, still featuring the powerful vocals of Steve Perry and the guitar works and keyboards by Neal Schon and Jonathan Cain. The band always used to be strong in delivering power ballads and *Girl Can't Help It*, the opening track of the LP, is a good example. We also like *Be Good To Yourself*, the uptempo solid rocker *Positive Touch* and the title track.

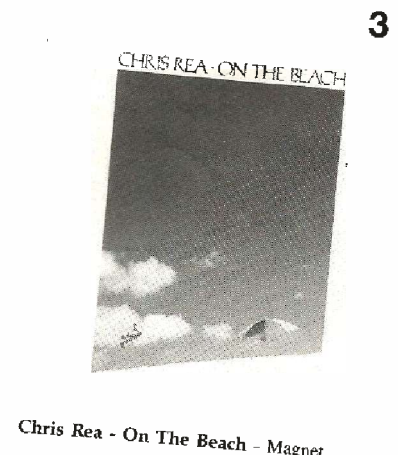
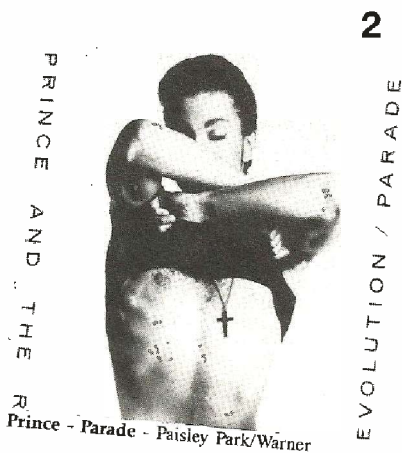
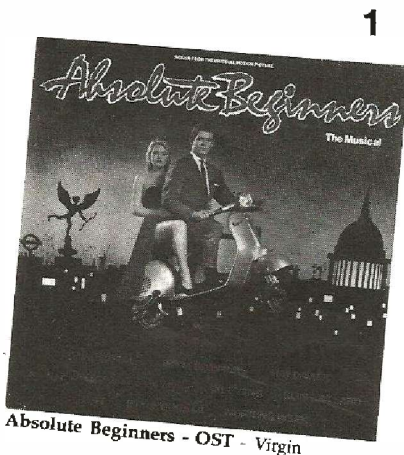

TV 6 REACHES VID CLIP DEAL

Only two months after its launch France's TV6 has reached agreement with record industry body SNEP on payments for video clip use. Similar agreements are expected shortly with La Cinq and Tele Monte Carlo, pay-tv service Canal Plus having concluded a clip deal back in 1984.

Under the terms of the TV6 agreement, which takes account of the channel's theoretical geographical coverage, payments will be no less than 4,000 FF (£372) per clip per screening.

However, there is still no agreement between SNEP and the state-controlled tv channels, which continue to regard record industry demands as excessive. With one side maintaining that clips are a form of disguised record promotion, and the other unlikely to settle for anything less than the 4,000 FF basis established with the Canal Plus and TV6 agreements, the chances of an early resolution to the dispute appear slim.

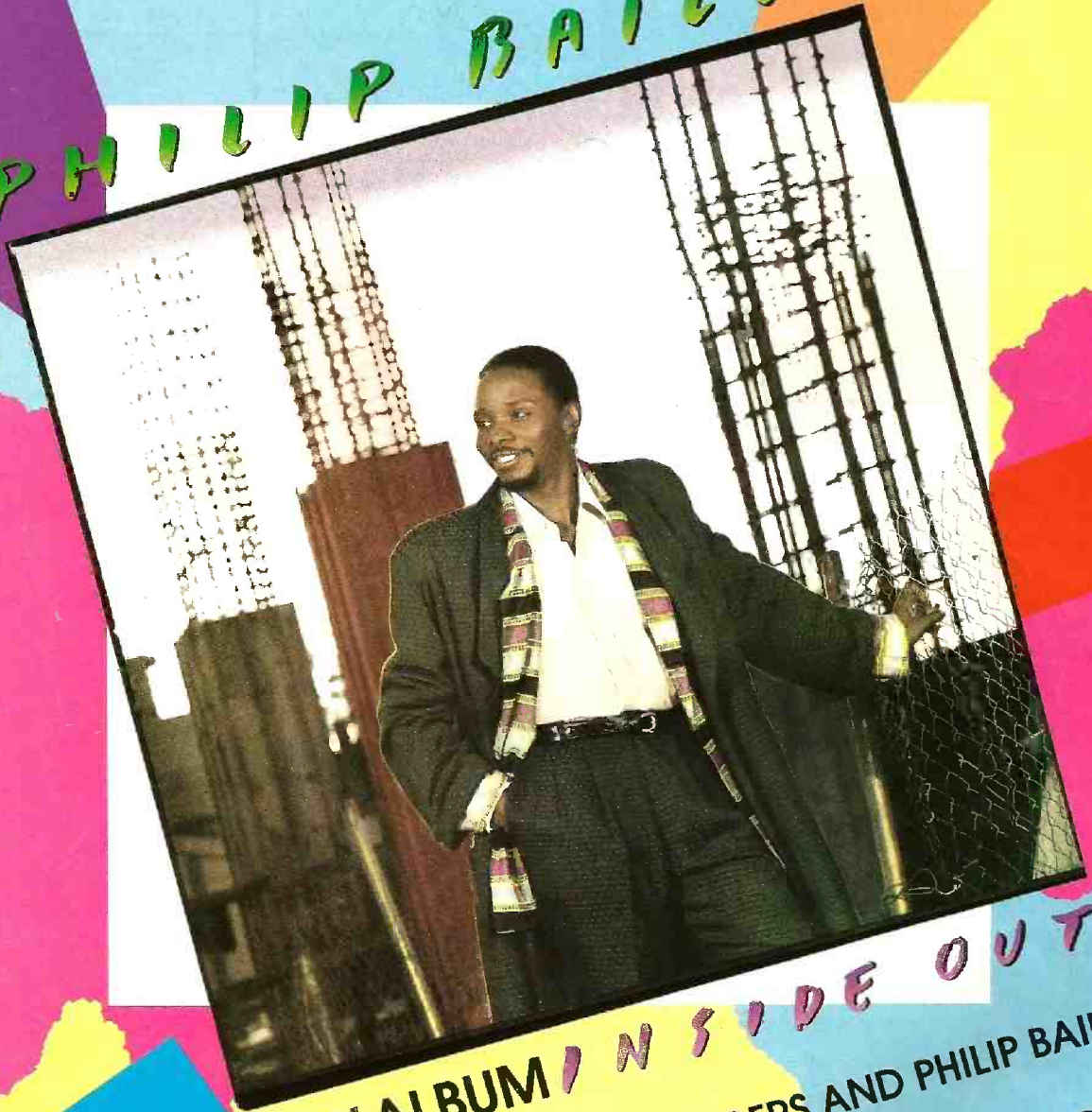

ITALIAN RECORD INDUSTRY ON THE UP CD's Cause For Optimism

by Vittorio Castelli

After several years of a downward turnover spiral, the Italian record industry found real reason for optimism in 1985, despite national economic problems.

Last year's turnover, at retail price level, hit a £106.5 million mark for records and prerecorded tapes, a 6.1% improvement on the figure posted in 1984. A 10% overall price increase levied by the government to ease Italian economic pressure clearly helped the turnover bottom line, but it affected only the October-December quarter's trade.

In unit terms, too, there was an increase of 4% up to 38,712 million, as against the 37,114 million of 1984. Industry leaders, most of them based in Milan now, see the statistics as being "distinctly positive".

The most significant trend is seen in the Compact Disc sector, Italy reflecting the action in virtually all pan-European territories. CD unit sales were up by 52.8% to just over a million units, last year and this factor gave the industry its biggest boost. But prerecorded cassettes were up to 11.4% on 1984, and LPs marginally up, by 1.6%. Singles, however, were down by 6.1% on the previous year.

In repertoire divisions, international pop product gained 14.4% on its 1984 market share, while Italian domestic pop was down 2.4% and

classical down 9.1%.

However Italian record companies put out 12% fewer new releases last year. And 1.8% of the total turnover was from the U.S.A. For Africa charity fund-raiser product.



For sales of more than 50,000 copies of the OST Rocky IV, James Brown, the Godfather of Soul received a Dutch Gold Disc. Brown's hit single Living in America is included on this sampler. DUTCH SALES BEST SINCE 1980 11.3% INCREASE IN TURNOVER

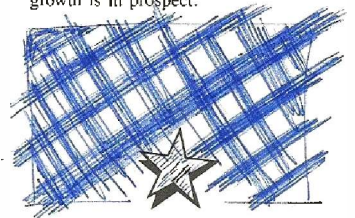
Dutch record industry turnover rose 11.3% last year to 540 million guilders (£144 million), trade body NVPI has announced. Much of the increase was due to the explosive growth in CD sales, which were

worth 65 million guilders (£17.3 million) compared with only 25 million (£6.6 million) in 1984.

Cassettes also performed well, with a 20% turnover increase to 90 million guilders (£24 million), while the value of LP and singles sales held steady at 305 million guilders (£81.3 million) and 80 million guilders (£21.3 million) respectively.

In unit terms, 15.7 million LPs, 5.5 million cassettes, 1.4 million CDs and 12.2 million singles were sold. CBS was the leading company with a 15.5% market share, followed by Phonogram (including Decca) with 14.5%, EMI with 12.4%, Polydor with 12% and WEA with 11.5%. Top independent company was CNR with a 5.2% share.

According to NVPI, the turnover figures are the best since 1980. The industry recession bottomed out in 1984 when earnings achieved a marginal 2% increase, and there is now optimism that a period of renewed growth is in prospect.

These include long and short forms and all are submitted for the international video competition in Montreux. Portions of the nominated and winning clips will be shown live and telecast on May 10th. Jury members include: Steve Dupler (Billboard Publications Inc.

USA), Steve Barron (Limelight Films Ltd. UK), Matt Forrest (Snapper Films at MGMM UK), Les Garland (MTV Networks Inc. USA), John Martin (MuchMusic Network Canada), Mike Hollingsworth (Music Box TV UK), Patrice Blanc-Francard (TV6) France, Pierre Luigi Stefani (Video Music Italy), Patrick Allenbach (RTSR Switzerland) and Machgiel Bakker (Music & Media Holland).



The success of the Hits Album/Tape continues in the UK with the current collection - Hits 4 - still riding high in the Album charts after five weeks and having comfortably reached platinum status.

This week's man of TV is undoubtedly BBC's Michael Hurl who together with his team is recording more than 35 superstars during 5 consecutive nights at the Golden Rose Festival and the International Music & Media Conference at Montreux. The recordings will be edited in 3 specials. Two 90-minute specials will be taped at the Golden Rose Rock Event and broadcast in approx. 23 countries over the next few months. The line-up this year is even more impressive than last with such artists as A-Ha, Billy Ocean, Bryan Adams, E.L.O., Genesis, Julian Lennon and Paul Hardcastle. The 3rd special will be the screening of the international New Talent festival (see page 11). These are expected to be seen by around 100 million viewers.

Born in 1936 in London, Michael Hurl was educated at St. Paul's School where he first became interested in the theatre through the school's dramatic society which included as one of its members Jonathan Miller who was later to base his "Beyond The Fringe" on these school productions.

In 1965 he joined the BBC and became a director. Since then he has been working in the BBC Light Entertainment Department rising from director/producer to executive producer. He has produced comedy and musical tv shows with nearly every well-known British and international artist and has worked on many BBC co-production including Abba in Switzerland, the Montreux Rock Festivals and "Disco In The Snow". Michael produced both the 1974 and 1982 Eurovision Song Contests and for the past 6 years has produced and directed the weekly BBC pop music programme "Top Of The Pops". Currently he is producing the Noel Edmonds' "Late Late Breakfast Show, Jonathan King's "Entertainment USA" and the "Two Ronnies" comedy series.

Commenting on the first IMMC, Michael said that he was more than delighted by the tremendous worldwide press coverage and by the live transmission of the Rock Gala in the UK, the States and Switzerland. He added: "It is undoubtedly one of the biggest rock galas in the world and its importance was proven by the fact that within only a couple of weeks we had confirmations from all the artists we wanted."



A special prize for the best pop video of the year will be awarded by the IMMC children of the world jury. Ten youngsters from all 5 continents in the 12-16 age bracket choose their favourite video for the occasion. The awards will be presented during the New International Talent TV Gala by some of the superstars present.

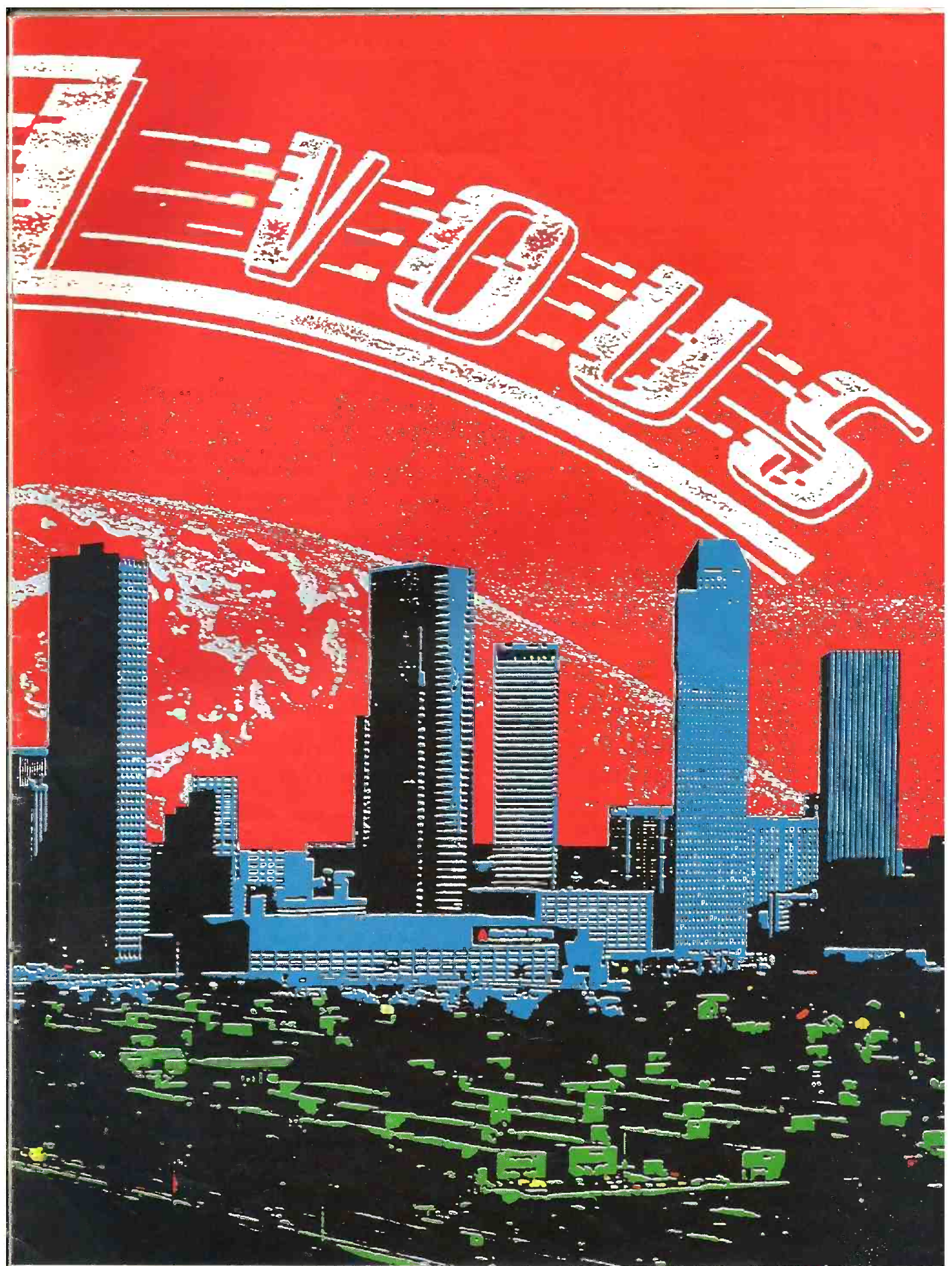
AMERICAN ACTS CANCEL TOURS

Three newcomers in the Top 10: **Sheila E.** (8-13), **Gerard Joling** and **Nicole** (10-15). Other good moves for sexy lady trio **Centerfold** (*Dictator* moving up from 22 to 12), **Bruce & Bongo's Geil** (16-20) and highest entry for **Sam Cooke's Wonderful World**.

BELGIUM

Cock Robin share the feat together with **Sandra and Survivor** of having the longest no. 1 chart-toppers in Belgium. Already for 4 weeks *The Promise You Made* is at 1 and yet again **Modern Talking** follows. After its new entry at 10 last week, *Living Doll* is now already up to no. 3 and the single stands very good chances of hitting the top next week. **George Michael** moves to 4 (from 8) and **Diana Ross's Chain Reaction** is new in the Top 10 (7-15). The biggest move however for **Madonna**, her *Live To Tell* sweeps Top 10: 9-38. Further good moves for **Simple Minds** (12-20), French Carriere singer **Sandra Kim** who has her MOR pop/disco ditty firmly planted in the Top 20 (15-21), **Survivor's I Can't Hold Back** (16-23) and highest entry for French singer **Michel Sardou** with his *1965* entering at 27. Second best entry for the kid song *Les Betises* by the young and innocent **Sabine Paturel** (on Carriere).

SPAIN

Jennifer Rush remains at no.1 for the fifth consecutive week followed by **Lionel Richie** and **Pet Shop Boys**. **Nacho Cano & German Coppini** are continuing their steady climb up the charts (10-14) as are **Fancy** (*Bolero*) who are at 14 after only 2 weeks and **Mr. Mister** whose *Broken Wings* rise to 13 from 22. German group **C.C. Catch** (produced by Dieter Bohlen of *Modern Talking* who are themselves at 6) have highest new entry with *I Can Lose My Heart Tonight* and the only other entry goes to **Survivor**.

SWITZERLAND

After a long struggle San Remo winner **Eros Ramazzotti** replaces **Muenchener Freiheit's Ohne Dich** at the no. 1 spot. **Bowie** is at 3 (coming from 5) and **Prince** moves up to 5 (from 7). **Five Star** is new in the Top 10 with *System Addict* (7-19) and **S.S. Sputnik** crash Top 10 (8-15). **Phil**

Carmen is new in the Top 10 with his *Moonshine Still*, a longtime Euro-crossover favourite from **M&M**. **Queen** are new at 13 followed by **Bruce & Bongo's Geil** entering at 14.

AUSTRIA

Muenchener Freiheit sticks at 1 with *Ohne Dich* and **Bruce & Bongo** rap to no. 2 (from 10). Straight in at 8 is **Bangles' Manic Monday** and a good move for **Bowie** as well (10-29). Other entries for **Prince** (*Kiss* new at 19) and local singer **Wolfgang Fierek** who picks up his girl with a tractor (*Resie, I Hol Di Mit Me'm Traktor Ab* new at 21).

ITALY

While **Joe Cocker's You Can Leave Your Hat On** sticks at 1, Magnet act **Kissing The Pink** creep up to no. 3 (from 8). New in the Top 10 is **George Michael** and **Culture Club** make a good move from 25 to 14. After the success of **Howard Jones' single No One Is To Blame** the Italians are suddenly picking up on this **Phil Collins** produced Jackson Browne-ish ballad. It is this week's highest entry at 16. **Talk Talk** follow close by with *Living In Another World* entering at 18.

DENMARK

Prince's sensual *Kiss* is for the 2nd week at no. 1 followed by local act **Trax** and **George Michael**. Highest entry for **Queen** (new at 8) followed by **Madonna's Live To Tell** (new at 9). **Cliff & The Young Ones** make a good move (10-17) as well as **Culture Club's Move Away** (12-26). Second best entry for **Princess' new single I'll Keep On Loving You** which enters this week at no. 20.
