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1 Introduction

This is in response to the following Action Item assigned to Lorna Priest.

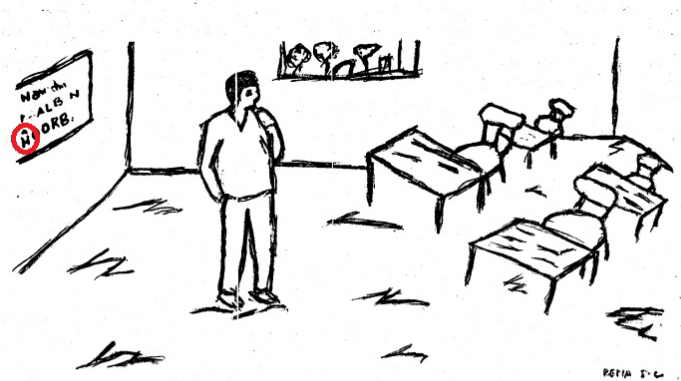
[123-A22] Action Item for Lorna Priest: Submit a new document with additional information on additional annotation, casing relations, for U+0266. Refer to [L2/10-166](#).

L2/10-166 said “Currently other languages we are aware of are using other options such as H’ or Ĥ for the uppercase to U+0266.” Further research has failed to discover any languages using H’. The Nawdm [nmz] language of Togo uses the lowercase h with hook (U+0266) in its orthography, but uses Ĥ (U+0124) for the upper case.
