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

- 20A3 F FRENCH FRANC SIGN
  - France
- 20A4 £ LIRA SIGN
  - intended for lira, but not widely used
  - ullet preferred character for lira is 00A3  ${f \pounds}$
  - →00A3 £ pound sign
  - → 20BA **t** turkish lira sign
- 20A5 m MILL SIGN
  - USA (1/10 cent)
- 20A6 N NAIRA SIGN
  - Nigeria
- 20A7 Pts PESETA SIGN
  - Spain
  - → 20B1 P peso sign
- 20A8 Rs RUPEE SIGN
  - India, unofficial legacy practice
  - → 20B9 ₹ indian rupee sign
  - $\approx$  0052  $\mathbf{R}$  0073  $\mathbf{s}$
- 20A9 ₩ WON SIGN
  - Korea
- 20AA ₪ NEW SHEQEL SIGN
  - Israel
- 20AB ₫ DONG SIGN
  - Vietnam
- 20AC € EURO SIGN
  - currency sign for the European Monetary Union
  - euro, not ecu
  - → 20A0 & euro-currency sign
- 20AD K KIP SIGN
  - Laos

- 20AE T TUGRIK SIGN
  - Mongolia
  - also transliterated as tugrug, tugric, tugrog, togrog, tögrög
- 20AF Do DRACHMA SIGN
  - Greece
- 20B0 & GERMAN PENNY SIGN
- 20B1 ₱ PESO SIGN
  - = Filipino peso sign
  - Philippines
  - extant and discontinued Latin-American peso currencies (Mexican, Chilean, Colombian, etc.) use the dollar sign
  - → 0024 \$ dollar sign
  - → 20A7 h peseta sign
- 20B2 G GUARANI SIGN
  - Paraguay
  - Often represented by G. or Gs.
- 20B3 A AUSTRAL SIGN
  - former Argentinian currency
- 20B4 ₹ HRYVNIA SIGN
  - Ukraine
- 20B5 C CEDI SIGN
  - Ghana
  - glyph may look like  $\mathcal{C}'$  or like C with a short vertical stroke through the upper arm
  - $\rightarrow$  00A2 ¢ cent sign
  - → 023B C latin capital letter c with stroke
- 20B6 tt LIVRE TOURNOIS SIGN
  - used in France from 13th-18th centuries
- 20B7 S SPESMILO SIGN
  - historical international currency associated with Esperanto
- 20B8 ₹ TENGE SIGN
  - Kazakhstan
  - $\rightarrow$  2351  $\overline{\top}$  apl functional symbol up tack overbar
  - → 2564 ⊤ box drawings down single and horizontal double
  - → 3012 T postal mark
- 20B9 ₹ INDIAN RUPEE SIGN
  - official rupee currency sign for India
  - contrasts with script-specific rupee signs and abbreviations
  - → 0930 ₹ devanagari letter ra
- 20BA ₺ TURKISH LIRA SIGN
  - official lira currency sign for Turkey
