The development of the Far East was declared a national priority for the entire 21st century by Russian President Vladimir Putin ten years ago. The President's directives sparked systemic changes; their results are already evident and will continue to influence the macroregion's future for many more years.

The Russian Federation government has enacted 73 federal laws in the last ten years. Advanced special economic zones, the free port of Vladivostok, and a preferential regime in the Kuril Islands have been established. Unprecedented government assistance programmes for the people have been introduced, including the Far Eastern Mortgage and Far Eastern Hectare. The National Far East Development Programme has been given the green light.

2,800 investment projects are currently being implemented, with 646 of them already up and running. These include enterprises essential to the development of our nation, such as the Zvezda shipyard, the

Udokan Mining and Metallurgical Plant, the Amur Gas Processing Plant and Amur Gas Chemical Complex, the Nakhodka Mineral Fertiliser Plant, and the Baim Mining and Processing Plant. The Far East has seen the creation of over 119,000 jobs and an investment inflow of RUB 3.2 trillion.

Around 600 new social infrastructure projects, including schools, hospitals, and kindergartens, have appeared in the macroregion.

The President's orders led to the establishment of the Far Eastern Federal University, the Primorye Stage of the Mariinsky Theatre, as well as regional Hermitage, Russian Museum, and Tretyakov Gallery branches.

An extensive programme to renovate cities in the Far East was started last year. History will be affected by the President's decision. It portends a bright future for the entire Far East, with a focus on improving living conditions for everyone.

Government support mechanisms are being improved through ongoing efforts.

We carefully study international practises, selecting the best, and adapting them to Russian conditions. A legislative proposal for an international ASEZ, created for the hi-tech initiatives of our international partners, is currently being developed.

The environment in which we work is changing right now. The Far East has become increasingly important to Russia's economic development as a result of the country's turn to the East, making it a vital transport corridor for international trade. This has forced us to meet new standards while also opening up a world of possibilities.

I am confident that the 2023 Eastern Economic Forum will help us address our nation's most pressing problems, and that those who attend it will discover the Far East, develop warm feelings towards it, discover fresh opportunities for collaboration, and decide to build their futures here.

On behalf of the President of the Russian Federation V. V. Putin, a system for allocating quotas for aquatic bioresource extraction in return for investment has been devised and put into action. Thanks to this system, contracts have been signed for the construction of 64 fishing vessels, 41 crabbing boats and 27 fish processing factories. Currently, 7 fishing vessels, 4 crabbing boats and 25 factories are in operation.

State-supported investments

The Far East and Arctic Development Corporation helps companies launch and grow their investment projects in the Far East and Arctic. There are six preferential territories: Advanced Special Economic Zones (ASEZs), the Free Port of Vladivostok (FPV), the Special Administrative Region (SAR), the Arctic Zone of the Russian Federation regime (AZRF), the Preferential Regime on the Kuril Islands (RKI), and the Russky Island Innovative Science and Technology Center (ISTC). Each territory provides beneficial tax regulations, streamlined administrative pro-

cesses, and other advantages. The government has used these territories to create some of the most advantageous business environments in Russia and the Asia-Pacific Region.

As a managing entity, FEDC aims to offer investors comprehensive support, including assistance with project structuring, financing, partner identification, product distribution, information dissemination, staffing needs, and resident rights protection. The Corporation works to ensure that every business initiative is implemented, new businesses are

established, jobs are created, and the standard of living for people in the Far East and Arctic is raised.

As of now, more than 3,400 residents of the ASEZ, FPV, AZRF, SAR, RKI, and ISTC are working on investment projects under their contracts with FEDC; businesses are poised to spend over RUB 7.7 trillion and create nearly 260,000 jobs. Over RUB 3.1 trillion has already been invested in the economy of our country, creating some 121,000 jobs. About 800 businesses, ranging from SMEs to significant processing facilities, are already up and running.

Investor's map

In 2022, FEDC released an investment map in five languages. On this digital platform, the most recent information is divided into five categories. It allows users to look up investment opportunities, select a land parcel or investment location based on predetermined criteria, and learn more about the infrastructure already in place. Both potential investors and current residents looking to expand their projects can benefit from using the map.

Providing businesses with land and all necessary infrastructure (for ASEZs) is one of FEDC's main duties. Investors are assigned land plots through a unique process. Entrepreneurs have received free land grants of about 2,000 hectares.



Avangard, a Khabarovsk ASEZ resident, is the first greenfield-type industrial park in the Far East accredited by the Ministry of Industry and Trade of the Russian Federation.

ASEZ

ASEZ residents are provided with land and ready-to-use infrastructure to carry out their projects. FEDC collaborates with regional authorities to ensure the provision of electricity, water, gas, sewage, and heating. A company will be compensated from

state funds if it builds the required infrastructure with its own resources. The ability to obtain full ownership of the plot at a cost 12 times less than market value after project completion, however, is the main benefit.

Aside from other privileges, ASEZs typically provide advan-

tages like no land tax, zero tax on profits for the first five years, and a 12% rate for the subsequent five years. There are currently 17 ASEZs in the Far East and one in Murmansk, 721 registered residents overall.

FPV

The Free Port of Vladivostok now boasts over 2,000 residents. The majority of these are SMEs. Over RUB 1.6 trillion worth of investments have been made within the FPV regime framework. Primorye Territory, Kamchatka Territory, Khabarovsk Territory, Sakhalin Oblast, and Chukotka Autonomous Area are the five Far Eastern regions covered by this regime.

The advantages of FPV are very similar to those of the ASEZ regime. They include reduced social obligation costs and zero income tax

for the first five years. Insurance payments are reduced from 30% to 7.6% for 10 years.

Furthermore, free customs zone procedures are allowed by ASEZ,

FPV, AZRF, and RKI. Residents of FPV and ASEZ may hire foreign workers. A single point of contact can be used by investors to access all services.



The organisers of the Urban Awards named the Zelyoniy Boulevard residential project by the eponymous developer company, an FPV resident, the best residential complex in Russia in 2022.



AZRF

The Russian Arctic zone (AZRF) is the largest special economic zone in the world. It extends across nine regions, from Chukotka to the Murmansk Region. With over 640 residents and an investment volume of more than RUB 800 billion since its establishment in 2020, it is already thriving.

Mineral extraction, LNG production, and hydrocarbon processing are the primary focus of its anchor projects.

However, big businesses are not the only ones drawn to the Arctic. Numerous SMEs with projects in the service sector, tourism, and other industries have received resident status here. They are given preferential rates under the simplified tax system (USN), as well as an insurance contribution rate reduced to 3.75%, as opposed to the larger AZRF companies' 7.5% rate.

RKI

The most recent preferential regime in the Far East was established in 2022 in Sakhalin Region's Yuzhno-Kurilsk, Kurilsk, and Severo-Kurilsk urban districts. It has 14 residents right now, but given its unique preferences, it has a lot of potential. For 20 years, a RKI resident will be fully exempt from a number of taxes. Profit tax, corporate property tax, land tax, and transportation tax will all be zero percent during this time.

SAR

Companies choosing to relocate from a foreign jurisdiction to Russia can take advantage of a Special Administrative Region (SAR), which offers a flexible tax and currency regulation regime. FEDC oversees one of the

two Russian SARs, situated on Russky Island in Primorye. 44 new participants, a record number, moved back home from offshore zones in 2023.

The SAR's main goal is to protect assets and create advantageous conditions for multinational holding companies with Russian roots. It is essential for them to ensure conditions that are at least as good as those in other jurisdictions, including by creating world-class business infrastructure on Russky Island. Additionally, SAR residents who meet certain criteria designed to foster regional development are eligible for tax breaks on dividends, interest, and royalties. Comprehensive assistance is provided to SAR residents by the Far East and Arctic Development Corporation.

Far Eastern Concession

The Far Eastern Concession, a new mechanism to hasten the creation of the engineering and social infrastructure required by Far Easterners, was introduced in 2021. Public-private partnerships are already being used to establish facilities for children's recreation, education, sports, and a comfortable urban environment.

Importantly, FEDC will offer extensive support and guidance throughout all phases of project execution, regardless of the regime or mechanism selected by the investor. The Corporation is continually working to improve the preferential terms, considering and putting into practice business suggestions for enhancing the ASEZ, FPV, AZRF, SAR, and RKI regimes. Furthermore, new preferential territories are being established; these are the International

ASEZ (IASEZ) and the Patriotic ASEZ. Projects with a significant added value will be able to attract foreign investment from friendly nations through the IASEZ mechanism. The Patriotic ASEZ is intended to support businesses that produce goods needed for the special military operation. Producers of the goods used in the special military operation as well as organisations that provide rehabilitation services are covered by the set of state support measures.

Your Far East

Every Russian who chooses to reside in the Far Eastern Federal District can rely on state assistance, which ranges from free land and mortgages with the lowest interest rates in the nation to assistance with education and career development.

A hectare to live and do business

The Hectare programme provides an opportunity to obtain a plot of land in the Far East or the Arctic with an area of up to 1 hectare for free use for 5 years online through the надальнийвосток.рф federal information system, as well as

free registration of its ownership or rent. A hectare can be acquired for personal farming, for starting a business, or for home construction using a Far Eastern mortgage, without any age restrictions. The Corporation for the Development of the Far East and Arctic has launched the ОсвойГектар.РФ comprehensive support portal to help program participants. It contains reference materials, useful instructions, including detailed video guides on how to choose and register land, information on additional support measures, template business plans and model solutions for the use of the hectare.

Over 7 years, 123 thousand citizens of the Russian Federation have acquired their own hectares of land. More than 40% of recipients selected land parcels for residential construction, about 35% use their hectares for agricultural development, and another 18%, for business purposes. After 5 years of use, more than 22,500 Russians registered ownership or rent of their hectares.

A kids' martial arts sports camp is a striking example of land development under the Far Eastern Hectare programme. The project was implemented in several phases on the island of

Kunashir. Two hectares were acquired by local trainers close to the Goryachiy Plyazh village's thermal water spring. In 2018, the first houses and a canteen for children, as well as a sauna, were built. The sports school develops young champions for the Sakhalin Region's team, which has already won numerous Far Eastern and nationwide competitions.

Over the course of seven years, more than 470 agglomerations—closely-spaced adjacent land plots provided under the Hectare program—have emerged in the Far Eastern Federal District. Such associations receive additional support. Roads are being built to agglomerations and electricity lines are being installed with the help of state budget funds.

More than 4,700 programme participants received assistance totaling



over RUB 3.4 billion (cumulative from 2017).

The Hectare programme was expanded in 2021 to include the Russian Federation's Arctic zone. The world's largest special economic zone spans across 9 regions. More than 5,000 Russians acquired land parcels in the Arctic for free two-year use.

In 2023, new land became available in the Komi Republic, Karelia, and Kamchatka.

Own homes for young families

The Far Eastern Mortgage programme for low-interest housing loans was launched in December 2019. Its stand-

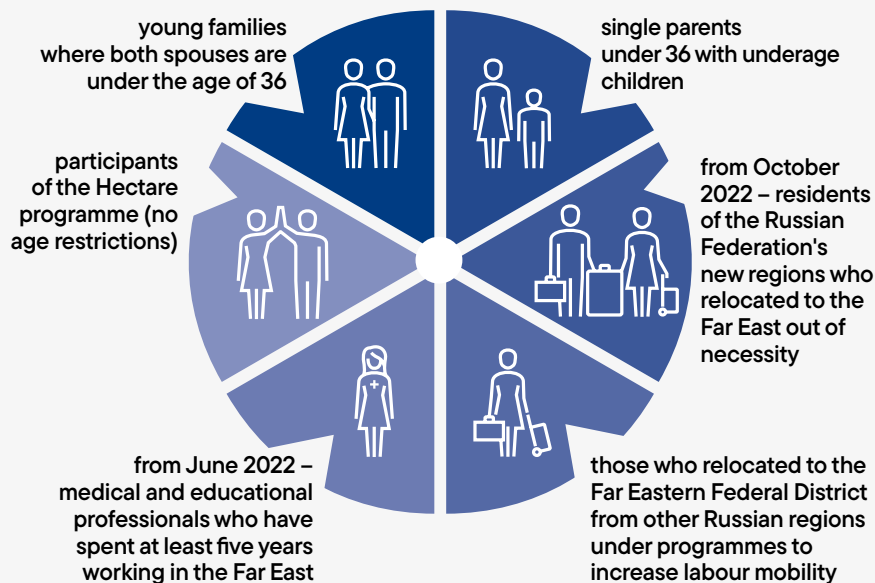

out feature is a historically low interest rate of 2% per annum, though it could go even lower depending on the participating banks' loyalty programmes.

One may take out a loan of up to RUB 6 million for a term of up to 20 years up until December 31, 2030, at an interest rate of no more than 2% per annum. 15% of the price of the purchased home must be put down (maternity capital or regional social payments may be used for this purpose). The loan can be used to purchase an apartment from a developer in a completed or under-construction building, secondary housing in a rural community, a single-industry city, as well as in any locality in the Magadan Region and the Chukotka Autonomous Area. A low-in-

terest loan is also offered for purchasing or constructing a private residence.

More than RUB 330 billion have already been issued in loans under the the Far Eastern Mortgage programme. Thus, 79,000 families in the Far Eastern Federal District were able to improve their housing conditions. The regions leading in loan disbursement volumes are the Primorsky Territory (over 22,000 loans totaling RUB 99 billion), the Republic of Sakha (Yakutia) (over 17,000 loans amounting to more than RUB 80 billion), and the Khabarovsk Territory (11,000 loans exceeding RUB 47 billion).

There are also plans to expand the Far Eastern Mortgage programme to the Russian Federation's Arctic zone.

It will be introduced in nine regions; Vladimir Putin, the president of Russia, endorsed this project.

Urban environment in focus

Integrated development projects in the cities of the Far Eastern Federal District are supported by the Far Eastern Quarter programme. By 2030, housing spanning 2.5 million square meters will be constructed in the Far East regions to accommodate 100 thousand inhabitants of the Primorsky, Khabarovsk, Kamchatka, and Trans-baikal Territories, as well as Sakhalin, Amur, and Jewish Autonomous Regions. The Far Eastern Mortgage programme will help in guaranteeing affordable real estate prices.

Future residents' preferences will be taken into consideration when designing the infrastructure of residential quarters, including schools, kindergartens, lighting, sports facilities and playgrounds, and landscaping. The Far Eastern Quarter programme was created in response to the widespread desire of contemporary society for a high-quality, comfortable urban setting with a developed architectural concept and regional sociocultural traits.

The Amur Territory, Kamchatka Territory, and Sakhalin Territory were the first regions to put the programme into practise. Plos for the development of nearly 700,000 sq.m of housing, a total of 160 hectares of land, were allocated. Some of the apartments will be

According to a November 2022 VTsIOM survey, more than half of the Far East residents (52%) know about the Far Eastern Quarter programme. 75% consider it useful for the residents of their city. 79% of Far Easterners are confident that the programme will help the development of the Far Eastern Federal District. 76% of respondents believe that the programme's implementation will improve life in their region. Moreover, about 69% of families with young children are confident that they will be the ones to live in new integrated development projects.

assigned for social needs. Delivery of the first stage of integrated development investment projects is scheduled for December 2025. Developers who became project executors received the status of ASEZ residents and corresponding benefits.

In 2023, developers of Far Eastern Quarters in Chita, Khabarovsk, Birobidzhan and Korsakov were selected. In the Arctic zone of the Russian Federation, the implementation of the Far North's first Arctic Quarter has begun in the Arkhangelsk Region.

Development as planned

Detailed master plans are the foundation for the growing prosperity of the cities in the Far Eastern Federal District. The latest trends in the construction and development of urban infrastructure, public demand for a comfortable environment, and the need for a social service platform are all taken into account in this novel approach to the development of large settlements. In the Far East, preferential regimes are in place where investors can operate, projects and production can begin, and regional economic growth can be restarted.

Far Eastern Quarters and other announced and ongoing investment projects are included in the master plans of the 25 largest cities in the Far Eastern Federal District. Thousands of new jobs will be created through the development of new educational and cultural institutions, recreational and tourist attractions, and anchor industries in agriculture and processing.

Talent pool

The Muravyov-Amurskiy 2030 public service training programme was launched by the Corporation for the Development of the Far East and Arctic with the help of the Ministry of the Russian Federation for the Development of the Far East and the Arctic. The Skolkovo School of Management and the Far Eastern Federal University

stepped up as the programme's educational partners.

The programme is a comprehensive training ground for aspiring public service managers rather than just another personnel competition. For a full year, trainees are completely immersed in the operations of the government agencies and regions of the Far Eastern Federal District.

The training aims to acquire fundamental knowledge in the areas of public administration, history, and Oriental studies as well as practical tools for handling governmental issues.

The training provided by the programme also implies a strong sectoral specialisation.

Trainees gain a thorough understanding of how government organisations function, how they interact during operational activities, and how to ad-

dress particular government issues while working closely with their mentors, including the governors of the Far Eastern Federal District regions. They also study the managerial style and personal experience of each mentor. The Mentor Council is headed by Aleksey Chekunkov, Minister for the Development of the Far East and the Arctic.

The inaugural class of the Muravyov-Amurskiy 2030 Programme graduated in March 2023. 47 trainees have completed a year's training and are already employed. Graduates of the programme are currently working in the regional public administration systems. They work on projects related to the growth of the economy, building and manufacturing, the social sector, and education. Many people relocated from other parts of Russia to the Far East.

Enrollment for the second class was opened in May 2023, and 3,305 applications from 81 Russian regions were received. 52 trainees entered the programme as a result.

Following global standards

The Russian Federation's Ministry of Science and Higher Education created a regional track of the Priority 2030 national academic leadership and university support programme in 2022 with the Far Eastern Federal District in mind. Raising Russia's competitiveness in higher education, science, and technology in the period from 2021 to 2030 is the project's primary objective. Far Eastern universities that are taking part in the Priority 2030 project will establish original educational programmes that take into account the business requirements and regional economic characteristics of the Far Eastern Federal District. The quality of higher education and the preparation of young specialists will improve, the volume of research work will rise, and as a result, universities will become full-fledged scientific and technological hubs of the Far Eastern Federal District.

35 universities in the Far Eastern Federal District applied for participa-

tion in the Priority 2030: Far East track. Aleksey Chekunkov, the Minister for the Development of the Far East and the Arctic, and Valeriy Falkov, the Minister for Science and Higher Education, sat the commission that chose the 12 winners based on the outcomes of the application pitching process.

Eight universities that won the first round of competition each received RUB 71.25 million in state funding in 2022. These are the Admiral Nevelskoy Maritime State University, Pacific State Medical University under the the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation, Arctic State Institute of Culture and Arts, Filippov Buryat State Agricultural Academy, Far Eastern State Agrarian University, Far Eastern State Academy of Physical Culture, Vitus Bering Kamchatka State University, and Blagoveshchensk State Pedagogical University. Following the sec-

ond round of selection in 2023, the Far Eastern State University of Railways, Transbaikalian State University, Sholem Aleichem Amur State University, and Sakhalin State University joined the Priority 2030: Far East project.

Along with these universities, three more Far Eastern institutions that are a part of the Priority 2030 federal track will also receive the basic portion of the federal grant in the amount of RUB 100 million each year. These are the Far Eastern Federal University, the Amosov North-Eastern Federal University, and the Pacific State University.

Twelve universities will use a total of about RUB 5.77 billion in grants through 2024. The funds will be used to upgrade the material and technical equipment, support faculty and students, foster academic mobility, buy instructional and laboratory equipment, and more.



Sakhalintech, the Sakhalin State University Campus construction project, was named one of the winners of the Priority 2030: Far East university development programme. In August 2023, a capsule with a letter to future SakhSU students was laid at the base of the campus building.

Far Eastern brand power

Over 200 residents who have met their investment obligations are currently using the Made in ASEZ FPV Far East trademark. The logo, which depicts a lotus, a symbol of collective creation, attests to the brand's high standards and solid track record in business. It suggests to partners and investors that the manufacturer has significant potential and competitive advantages and enjoys systemic state support. The idea of distinctive Far Eastern quality, along with safety and modern technology, is also communicated to the customer.

Residents of advanced special economic zones and the free port of Vladivostok benefit from a wide range of state assistance measures, including marketing support. It was decided to group the goods and services provided by residents under a single brand in order to promote them in Russia and the Asia-Pacific region.

The Made in ASEZ FPV Far East trademark was created in 2019 by the FEDC on orders from Yuriy Trutnev, Deputy Prime Minister of the Russian Federation and Plenipotentiary Presidential Envoy in the Far Eastern Federal District, with



assistance from the Ministry of the Russian Federation for the Development of the Far East and the Arctic.

A lotus-themed logo won the bidding on the eve of the Eastern Economic Forum 2019. All 45 of the International Classification's categories of goods and services are covered by the trademark registration. A contemporary Far Eastern brand to promote goods made under the new economic regimes entered the market.

ASEZ and FPV residents who have fulfilled their stated investment obligations in the Far Eastern

region can use the trademark. The marking serves as a further assurance of the resident's dependability as a partner and supplier and verifies that the resident has successfully completed the process of project development, contract signing with the FEDC, and business launch.

The production of goods or rendering of services must also adhere to GOST standards, technical requirements, and regulations. Documents attesting to the product's or service's safety must be present.

As of right now, 749 residents have completed their projects in the

FPV and ASEZ. Over 200 of them use the Made in ASEZ FPV Far East trademark to promote innovative solutions, distinctive, high-quality goods and services, and to raise their profile in Russia and the Asia-Pacific region.

Applicants must fill out a form on the FEDC website and sign a separate contract with the Corporation

for the right to use the trademark. This right is granted to the resident without charge, like all other services. The mark can be used not only on labels and packaging, but also on websites and advertising materials, transport, or any outdoor and indoor structures.

Another support measure is the promotion of goods and services through the printed and online cat-

alogues by FEDC and the Ministry for Development of the Russian Far East, handed out at significant Russian and international events all year long.

million tonnes, is almost finished. The Inaglinskaya mine opened in 2020 to supply coal to the processing plants.

The Denisovskiy mining and processing plant has been under construction since 2004. Its mine is the first in Russia's coal industry to use the pillar-and-breast system for coal seam extraction, including at depths greater than 200 metres. This underground mining method reduces the loss of coal reserves and ensures effective mining in challenging geological conditions. Every year, the mine produces 2 million tonnes of coal. The Vostochnaya Denisovskaya mine began operations in 2021 with a 4-million-tonne annual coal production capacity. The Denisovskaya processing plant, with a 6-million-tonne annual capacity, receives the coal mined there.

Combining mining and processing plants with a private sea coal terminal resulted in an integrated production and logistics solution for mineral extraction, processing, transportation, and transshipment for further export to Asia-Pacific countries. This is in line with the government's objective of raising the share of coal exports from Russia. Leading metallurgical plants in China and Japan are buyers of Yakutian high-grade coking coal.

VaninoTransUgol (VTU), a resident of the Free Port, has built and runs the first phase of a coal transshipment facility in the Vanino seaport.

A specialised terminal with cutting-edge machinery for coal transshipment and dust suppression uses the best coal handling technologies on the market. The General Board of State Expert Review and the State Environmental Review have given the project documentation favourable reviews.

In addition to a 350-meter berth for maritime cargo, the terminal also features rail infrastructure, a conveyor transport system with transfer stations, a coal storage area, a fire depot, and waste treatment facilities.

A ship loader with a 6,000-tonne-per-hour capacity is installed on the cargo berth. Ships with a deadweight of up to 150,000 tonnes can be loaded at the terminal thanks to the depth at the berth and in the water area.

The terminal's railway section consists of tracks and an unloading station that can hold trains up to 70 rail-



A pilot project has been put into place at the maritime checkpoint at the VaninoTransUgol terminal to streamline the state control process and clearance of ships arriving for loading. The terminal's cargo turnover will rise by 1.5 million tonnes annually as a result of implementing this streamlined procedure, which cuts vessel inspection times by 4-6 hours. The steps needed to include these changes in the regulatory documentation are currently being taken





cars long. It has two tandem railcar tippers with powerful aspiration systems to capture coal dust, two defrosting devices, and a sprinkler system that aids in settling dust particles.

Once unloaded from the railcars, the cargo is forwarded to the coal storage area or directly onto the vessel via a network of conveyor lines and transfer stations. Semi-spherical roofs shield the conveyors along their entire length, trapping coal dust inside. Two stacker reclaimers with a capacity of up to 6,000 tonnes per hour are used for stacking and de-stacking at the coal storage area. The storage area has a maximum capacity of 1 million tonnes.

The establishment of the second dock with a ship loader, further development of the conveyor system with transfer stations, and increasing the coal storage capacity to 2 million tonnes with two additional stacker-reclaimers are all part of the VTU terminal's full-scale development. This phase will have a capacity of up to 24 million tonnes per year.

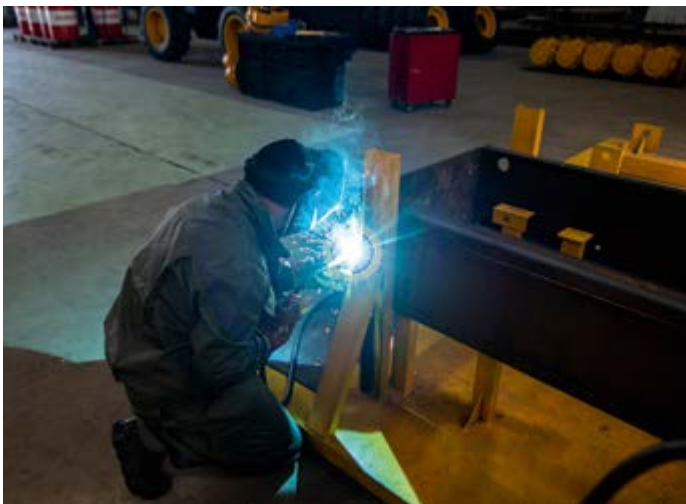

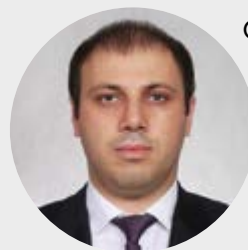
