Notes:

^a Companies are ranked according to the value of their arms sales in 2000. Companies with a designation in square brackets [] are ranked according to a rough estimate of their arms sales, in which case there is a (.) in the column for arms sales. Companies with the designation S in the column for rank are subsidiaries. A dash (–) in the column for rank designations indicates either that the company did not produce arms in 1999, or that it did not exist in 1999 as it was structured in 2000, in which case there is a zero (0) in column 7, or that it did not rank among the 100 largest companies in 1999. Rank designations in the column for 1999 may not correspond to those given in table 4D.2 in the *SIPRI Yearbook 2001* because of subsequent revision.

^b Key to abbreviations: A = artillery, Ac = aircraft, El = electronics, Eng = engines, Mi = missiles, MV = military vehicles, SA/A = small arms/ammunition, Sh = ships, and Oth = other. Comp () = components of the product within the parentheses. It is used only for companies which do not produce any final systems.

^c The European Aeronautic Defence and Space Company (EADS) was created in July 2000 through the merger of DaimlerChrysler Aerospace (with the exception of MTU), Aérospatiale Matra, and Construcciones Aeronáuticas (CASA). The company is owned by 33% by DaimlerChrysler, (Germany), 31% by private investors, 15% by Lagardère (France), 15% by the French state (through direct and indirect share holdings), and 6% by SEPI (Spain). EADS is registered in the Netherlands.

^d Data for Thales are pro-forma sales as if the acquisition of Racal (UK) had occurred on 1 Jan. 2000. Racal was acquired by Thales in Aug. 2000.

^e For Japanese companies figures in the arms sales column represent new military contracts rather than arms sales.

^f The former arms-producing subsidiary of IRI (state) was partly privatized in June 2000. The share of Finmeccanica owned by IRI was reduced from more than 50% to 5%. An additional 32% of Finmeccanica is directly owned by the Italian Treasury.

^g This company is a provider of IT services and products to defence ministries. Figures are for total sales to defence ministries, an unknown share of which is for military applications.

^h The company is owned by the private investment group The Carlyle Group.

ⁱ Data for Snecma are pro-forma sales as if the acquisition of Labinal had occurred on 1 Jan. 2000. Labinal was acquired by Snecma in July 2000.

^j Data for Elbit Systems are pro-forma sales as if the acquisition of El-Op had occurred on 1 Jan. 2000. El-Op was acquired by Elbit Systems in July 2000.

^k In July 2001 Rockwell International spun off its avionics and communications business in Rockwell Collins.

^l In Oct. 2001 Gencorp sold part of the arms-producing activities within its Aerojet division to Northrop Grumman.

^m Development Management is owned by the US company Halliburton since 1996.

ⁿ This company operates Federally Funded Research and Development Centers (FFRDC) for the US Department of Defense.

^o IZAR was established in July 2000 through the merger of the SEPI (state) owned naval shipyard Bazan and the private civilian shipyard Astilleros Españoles. The company is fully owned by SEPI.

^p Alcoa acquired Cordant Technologies in May 2000. Arms sales for Cordant Technologies are for 1999. In Apr. 2001 Alcoa sold Thiokol Propulsion (part of Cordant Technologies) to Alliant Tech Systems.

^qAM General is owned by Renco Group.

^r In Aug. 2001 Motorola sold its arms-producing subsidiary Integrated Information Systems Group to General Dynamics.

^s In July 2001 Nissan Motor sold its aerospace and defence division to Ishikawajima-Harima.
