

## Opposition to 30-Year Eagle Take Permits

In April 2012, the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service [proposed to extend](#) the maximum length of programmatic eagle take permits to 30 years, from their current maximum length of five years. Public comments FWS received are posted on [www.regulations.gov](http://www.regulations.gov), under docket # [FWS-R9-MB-2011-0054](#). Below are some of the organizations that expressed opposition to changing the current regulations to allow 30 year eagle take permits.
