## Private Radio Bill Passed By Austrian Gov't

The Austrian Parliament has passed a bill to legalise private radio, with licences to be allocated by mid-'94. A 20-member licensing authority is to be set up with one member for each of the country's seven federal states and the rest representing the political parties and various social groups.

Broadcasting will not commence in Austria until '95, however, says Association of Independent Radio chairman Walter Tributsch, also MD of leading EHR private CD International. "The licences will be given out by mid-94, but that doesn't mean commercial broadcasting can begin straight away. There are

technical problems which must be solved first. Stations must first find transmitter and antenna positions in Austria and this is very hard as all the important positions are presently covered by state radio. I think it will take at least half a year before this problem is solved."

Ownership regulations in the bill limit the print media to a 26% interest in the first radio station and 10% for two additional stations. Advertising will be limited to 15% in any hour and to 1.5 hours a day.

The Liberal Democrat opposition party has condemned the bill, which it says won't allow private broadcasters to really compete with pubcaster ORF and won't

## BBC Radio 1 Names Bannister Controller

UNITED KINGDOM

BBC Radio One has tapped former GLR managing editor Matthew Bannister as the man to lead it in its drive to be more alternative and closer to its audience. Bannister replaces Johnny Beerling, who announced in late June that he would step aside on October 29 after eight-and-a-half years at the helm (M&M July 3).

While Bannister declined to comment at presstime, sources indicate extensive programming and personnel changes are in the offing when the network unveils its autumn schedule in September.

Radio One's new direction was hinted at in a speech before the Radio Academy on

## Strong June Propels French Music Business

FRANCE

With a 25% increase in value and units compared to the same month last year, June 1993 will be remembered by the music industry as showing the first signs of a possible recovery. Following three months of negative results,

June figures have helped push overall sales for the first six months to a 6% increase in value, according to figures supplied by music industry body SNEP.

During the period, total sales (wholesale price) reached Ffr2.69 billion (app. US\$463.7 million), of which singles represented Ffr155 million (up 37.7%) and albums Ffr2.467 billion (+3.7%). In units, single sales jumped two million to 8.5 million (+29%), while album sales climbed only slightly forward to 48 million from 45 million last year (+6%). Cumulative CD single sales reached 5.9 million units, up 283% from 1.5 million in 1992,

# Radio F Top Nuremberg Private; Pubcaster Bayern 1 Still Leader

**GERMANY**

It's all change in the Nuremberg radio market, as revealed by this year's Bavaria Infratest ratings for the city. ACE/Gold **Radio F** has moved ahead of EHR statewide private **Antenne Bayern** and EHR local station **Radio Charivari**, with a 5% increase in daily listeners to 105,000, making it the number one private station in Nuremberg. Schlager-formatted pubcaster **Bayern 1**, meanwhile, continues its hold as the number one station in the market, climbing 6.2% to 256,000 listeners.

Radio F PD **Sigi Hoga** puts the station's success down to a strong morning show and to the change in format over the last year. "We used to have a more schlager-based MOR format, but we've cut down on the schlager and added some younger material," he says. "Now we are number one in our 30-59 target group, even ahead of public station **Bayrischer Rundfunk**."

The gap in audience ratings between public and private stations is now narrowing—Radio F lies

just 34,000 listeners behind number two ranked EHR pubcaster **Bayern 3**, which drew 139,000 listeners per day, a drop of 33.8% from last year.

ACE station **Radio Charivari**, top of the local stations in last year's Infratest, dropped 4.9% to 103,000 listeners daily. That's still ahead of Munich-based EHR station **Antenne Bayern**, which suffered a 17.8% fall in listeners to 101,000.

Gaining listeners is EHR local **Radio Gong**, up by 4.6% to 91,000. Gong flipped formats last year from Hot ACE back to its original EHR.

The most dramatic growth among the Nuremberg local stations, however, is by EHR/dance **Hit Radio N1**, which increased its daily listeners by a blistering 64.3% to 69,000. Last year the station dropped 8%, losing listeners to Gong in an effort to target older listeners. Now PD **Cetin Yaman** thinks he's got the right formula. "The most important reason for N1's good ratings is that we've gone back to playing mostly current music, with 90% of our music from '92-'93. Most EHR stations in

Germany are afraid to play **Capella**, **Naughty By Nature**, **Snow** and **U 96** during the daytime programming because they think it would lead older people to tune out. Our success shows that this isn't necessarily so. Besides being number one in our prime 14-29 target group, we also hold the number two position in the 14-39 target group behind **Radio Gong**."

Yaman also says that the station's return to a "European" format from a US programming style is another reason for the upturn in ratings, with more freedom now given to N1's presenters.

# Lang Calls For Greater Creative Freedom At New Music Seminar

Former French minister of culture **Jack Lang** addressed audiences with his concerns about the future of artistic creation in his keynote speech at the **New Music Seminar (NMS)** in New York, pleading in favour of a greater circulation of artists and their works throughout the world.

At the centre of his speech was a call for a reduction in both political and economic censorship. "Those who have the power to control the media of expression can modify that expression, prohibit it, or, more subtly, ignore it," he said. "One way or another, the result is censorship."

As one example he cited **MTV** in its early years as a channel where "there were practically no African, American or minority artists on the playlist. Luckily, that is changing."

Lang played it safe before his **NMS** audience by evoking the case of rapper **Ice-T**, whose **Body Count** album was the cause of serious controversy last year. "Be it rap, rock or pop, lyrics reflect society. As we say in France, 'Breaking the thermometer does not break the fever.' If lyrics hurt, then it is society that needs reforming. In all democracies, there are of course prohibitions against inciting violence or racism, but these should allow freedom of speech."

Lang also invited governments

to allow the free movement of artists, taking the example of the US, where artists face the double obstacle of administrative hurdles and a routine lack of awareness of non-English language material in standard programming. "Obtaining a visa to come and perform in the US is very time consuming, very difficult, and very expensive," said Lang, who compared it with the "simple" European system. "I have too much respect and admiration for [America's] love of freedom to understand this discrepancy."

He also pointed out that to retain creative freedom, the rights of artists, performers, composers, publishers and producers must be protected. He pleaded for the existence in the US of "moral rights" for composers and lyricists, already recognised all around Europe, apart from the UK. "The moral right states that a record is not a product like a car, a tube of toothpaste, or a bar of soap," said Lang. "If there is to be one absolute rule, it is that artists must control as far as possible the destiny of their creation."

Lang called for a strengthening of "neighbouring rights" (performing rights and blank tape levies) to compensate artists, composers, lyricists, publishers and producers for the use of their works on radio or TV stations, adding that they can be a "source of tremendous revenue."

"The remarkably fast pace of technological change will make these, and other yet-to-be invented

rights essential to the well-being and the survival of those who make music," commented Lang. "Digital playback and fibre optic compression will result in countless new means of distribution, and true interactivity. We are entering a music world without frontiers."

For Lang, these major technological breakthroughs can change the way the music industry is structured and could lead to an "even greater concentration of economic power in the industry," as they will require massive investments. This could pose a threat to independent producers he forecasts, but underlined that independent producers will always be best positioned to discover new talent and new trends—"provided we find ways to ensure that their work is heard."

Another concern for Lang is the demise of physical carriers for music "which will deprive artists and producers of the bulk of their revenues." According to Lang, one answer could be the enforcement of neighbouring rights.

He concluded that a revolution is imminent in the music industry, adding, "The worst outcome would be if the coming revolutions result in fewer artists, producers and publishers, and if they produce a uniformity in music, in tastes and in culture. The best outcome would be if, on the contrary, they allow economic and cultural exchanges to multiply, if they expand markets and musical fluency, and if they respect diversity."

### HOLLAND: Radio 10 Gold Plays More National Product

Amsterdam-based national cable/satellite net **Radio 10 Gold** is to increase its share of national product from 25% to 30%. The station says it is making the change after a recent listener survey showed that 40% of listeners would like to hear more Dutch music. The station also reports a big success for its programme "History Of Dutch Pop music" which has doubled in listeners since it began.

## SACEM Figures Show Limited Decline

### FRANCE

After years of constant growth, license fees collected by authors' rights society SACEM have slightly declined by 0.8% in '92 to Ffr2.67 billion (US\$494 million). But the sums distributed to rights owners have increased by 6.2% to Ffr2.06 billion.

SACEM notes that audiovisual media are "more than ever" the main source of revenues for SACEM and that "despite the economical crisis 1992 has been particularly good for TV." Revenues from public stations (Radio France, RFI and RFO) increased by 3.1%, while revenues from local FM stations grew by 4%, but the rhythm has slowed compared with previous years (32.0% in '90 and 51.3% in '91).

SACEM says that "unless there is a radical change from the advertising market, the expansion of this media has globally reached its ceiling. The revenues of full-service stations are declining with the exception of Europe 1, and after a series of tough years, this station has been able to consolidate its audience, which has not been the case of RMC and RTL."

In terms of repertoire, SACEM notes that the "use of works of French origin remains dominant in France, all areas combined [radio, TV, concerts, shows, public use of music] and even shows a slight recovery at 53.4% of the total sums distributed against 52.5% in '91." SACEM confirms the decline of national repertoire in record sales with 41.1% of the mechanical rights, down 1.1% from '91.

As for radio stations, SACEM comments, "The programming on radio stations and TV channels remains open to French repertoire which represents 55.6% for radio and 55.8% for TV. This programming remains more or less at the same level as '91. TF1, France 2

for TV and radio stations France Inter, RTL, Nostalgie, Europe 1 and RMC are above 60%. But the analysis of the amounts distributed to French rights owners shows that the trend towards a marginalisation of the national repertoire continued on certain FM networks specialised in the English-spoken repertoire."

Over 29,000 SACEM members out of some 50,000 received a payment for the use of their works. Only 88 received over Ffr1 million and more than 15,000 less than Ffr6,000. SACEM's rights in '92 originated from: audiovisual media (28.3%, with TV channels accounting for 21.4% and radio stations for 7.0%), public use of recorded music (22.4%), mechanical rights for records, tapes and videos (14.9%) and blank tape levy (6.1%), foreign rights (17.8%), performing rights (7.7%) and cinema (2.0%). # Europe Developpement Cashes In On Aggressive Strategy

Four years after launching an international expansion plan, Europe Developpement, the affiliate of Europe 1—the French full service station operated by giant publisher Hachette—sees the first return of an aggressive and risky strategy and can now claim to be the leading international group operating music radio stations in Europe.

The group already owns and/or operates stations in Germany, the Czech republic, Slovakia (Europa 2), Poland (Radio Zet), Russia (Europa Plus—going national via satellite); it has interests in Spain and the UK and is making moves to enter the Hungarian (Budapest) market soon; it is set to launch the first national full-service FM network in the Czech republic in October (Frekvence 1) and is bidding for a national network in Poland.

Today, all Europe Developpement operations are leaders on their markets despite tougher competition, according to GM Martin Brisac, and recent Mediametrie ratings confirm this in Poland and the Czech republic. Although declining to give specific details country by country, Brisac says that all operations are self efficient and making a profit. The combined turnover for stations in the three Eastern countries exceeds Ffr50 million (app. US\$9.2 million).

The profitability of these stations "reached the same level as most similar stations," he adds. Start-up costs for each country are estimated at Ffr10 million. The most important event in the near future will be the opening on October 27 of Frekvence 1, the

first national FM network in the Czech Republic. Europe Developpement will own 55% of the new station, in partnership with Radio Golem and the Czech national insurance company. "It will be the first national private station in the history of the country," says Europa 2 GM Michel Fleischmann.

The annual budget of the station will amount to some US\$1.4 million. The company estimates that break-even will be reached in 1994 and profit in 1996. "We will be very much inspired by what has been done in France with Europe 1 and in Poland with Radio Zet," says Fleischmann. "It is a real challenge. We are going to create a new station from nothing." Brisac declines to reveal the backbone of the programming, but says it will be mostly news and music. Leaks suggest that there might be a strong share of country and classical music among the programming.

For Brisac, the development in other Eastern countries is linked to the economic situation and political stability. "There is a big

chance that we will enter other markets in the next years. We have focused so far on the countries that were most developed. We'll evaluate the other countries and make our decisions by taking into account their political and economic situation."

For Brisac, the most difficult thing faced during the past years was to find people who were able to work in a market-driven economy. "You can't wipe out 40 years of communism in just three years," he says. "And in the case of Russia, it's 70 years of communism. There is a lot of training to do [among both radio staff and advertisers]. When we entered some countries there was nothing—no advertising agencies, no sales reps, while advertisers had no knowledge of what advertising meant for them. But it catches on quickly. Take a look at Russia. Our turnover has made serious jumps. Two years ago, I was not very comfortable with Russia, but I think now that the political situation is more or less stable and that the economy is starting to be back on the tracks."

## Norway's P4 Under Way, Test Sending Unveils ACE Flavour

Private commercial radio station P4, expected to start broadcasting on September 15, began test sending on July 19 on FM 103.9 in Oslo, broadcasting on-air promos and music falling into a mainstream ACE format.

Reaching an estimated 900,000 listeners, the station began its test sending with Olav Stedje's *Sommar-song*, The Eagles *Hotel California* and Sade's *No Ordinary Love*.

P4 general manager Svein Larsen claims the station will reach 60% of Norway's population by its launching date,

and estimates that percentage to increase to 90% by 1995. P4's headquarters will be based in Lillehammer, with offices in Oslo and Tromsø.

The P4 management group consists of Larsen, PD Kalle Lisberg, sales/marketing director Tom Blomberg PR director Gier Holm and music/research editor Alison Chase.

The station expects to capture a third of the radio advertising pie, which in 1995-96 is estimated to amount to Nkr300 million (app. US\$43.6 million). P4 is owned by Kinnevik, Malmship, Endre Røsjø and Tharald Brøvig, each holding 20% of the shares.

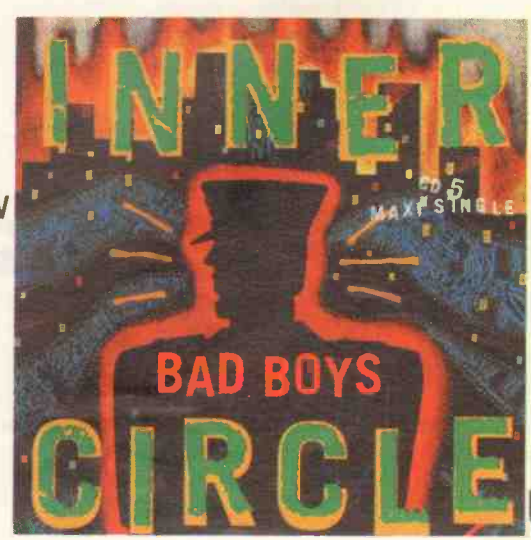

# PDs Outline Vacation Programming Tips

July and August are vacation months in Europe, and that means a healthy number of your listeners have left the city for the sunny beaches in the Mediterranean for the next three or so weeks. Left behind the summer migration, however, is a loyal audience who will continue to tune into your station. A trio of EHR programmers share how they serve those urban dwellers during the vacation months.

For **Martin Schwebel**, head of music at EHR/Gold **Radio Regenbogen/Mannheim**, increasing the music output and staying interactive with listeners via giveaways, games and contests are the keys to success. "At the beginning of July we begin our summer programme, which means there's less talk and more music," says Schwebel, whose station targets a 15-50 demo, with the core aged 20-40.

## Increasing Promotions

"We increase the number of games and giveaways—like T-shirts and CDs—more than we normally do. We get the listeners to participate in these summer activities, like our karaoke promotion. We also want people from outside the city to reach us by fax; we'll take our two trucks and visit them on-site. The idea behind it is that we do something for the people who stay at home. The whole thing is called simply,

'Summer Programme.' The participation is great; we get loads of faxes and letters and people seem to like it."

Sponsors for such events include a furniture company and an ice cream manufacturer.

Schwebel says he doesn't see any shift in demographics during the vacation months. "I don't think the demographic changes all that much," he says. "People

who go on vacation are from all age and income groups. It's just fewer people."

The station's rotation strategy remains the same, consisting of a "Hot Rotation"

playlist (15-17 titles aired three times daily), an A list (25 titles aired one time daily) and a B list (about 60 titles aired two/three times weekly).

Radio Regenbogen, however, isn't immune to the vacation period; the station also has to operate with fewer personnel. Schwebel explains how he copes, "We have DJs take longer shifts so we need fewer per day. We use three DJs during the vacation months where we normally have five. We also offer less talk and more music, so less production work is involved."

To start getting listeners in the summer mood, Schwebel starts programming changes in July. "When it starts getting warmer we start adding more reggae and swingy music," he says. "We're trying to deliver a summer mood to our listeners without changing the tempo of the music."

"I think people like soft songs during these months. **UB40's** (*I Can't Help*) *Falling In Love With You* is a soft song; it's a very popular song. People like that kind of song, especially in the summer. I don't think that summer means uptempo. Summer means good mood; good mood doesn't really mean uptempo. Our mood is relaxed and swingy."

Even EHR/Dance-formatted **Jeronimo Groovy/Athens**, located in the gateway to the Greek islands, finds itself effected by the summer holiday exodus. "I think in

Athens, which is a city of about four-million people, only about half of the population is left," says PD **Panos Protopapas**, whose station is number one in its 12-24

demo. "We continue to programme our station in a normal way, which is what the listeners in the city and tourists are used to listening to back home. In the past we had news bulletins in English, French and some other languages for the tourists, but now we have stopped

those completely. It didn't make any impact."

## Local Concerts

To give the locals a little value-added service, **Jeronimo Groovy** puts on several beach parties during the vacation months. "We usually do one very big beach party, which was done in July and about 1,000 people attended," says Protopapas. "We also have several other outdoor concerts with local and regional artists. We're planning one more big beach party at the end of August."

Programming changes are more subtle, and are a part of the station's summer strategy. The afternoon dance show opens one hour earlier (14.00-18.00) in the summer, and the evening's talk show begins one hour later at 01.00. "We think it's better to serve listeners with more music and less talk during those periods," says Protopapas.

Rotation strategy remains the same. The station spins about 16 songs per hour, concentrating on its A list (five-six titles played seven-eight times daily) and B list (five-six titles played five-six times daily).

Says Protopapas, "Usually we increase the tempo of songs during the summer, especially August. We pick up the tempo because we feel our audience wants to hear faster-paced music. We also put the more of the uptempo songs on higher rotation."

## Cultural Events

For **Marc Dhollander**, head of music at EHR/Gold **Radio Expres/Antwerp**, keeping listeners informed about local events and helping them get there free, helps build brand loyalty.

"Every day we broadcast new informa-

tion about activities in Antwerp," says Dhollander, whose station targets 25-50 demo. "We have more giveaways for our listeners for cultural events, music events and films. We also have more holiday-oriented games, like giving away maps and small things. We do things like this all year, but in the summer we give it a summer, holiday dimension."

For sponsors, **Radio Expres** works with a concert touring club in the summer, a couple of restaurants in Antwerp and the company that organises "Summer Nights." "We also do a 'cafe of the day promotion,' where listeners can get a free drink," he says. That promotion is sponsored by **Interbrew**, one of the country's largest breweries.

Like **Radio Regenbogen's** Schwebel, Dhollander says he doesn't notice any changes in demographics or listening patterns. Unlike Regenbogen, however, Dhollander's listeners usually take their vacation in July, so programming changes begin earlier.

"People get the summer feeling when

the weather changes, so we tend to start with small changes in June," he says. "We increase the summer hits in July and August. Most of the time we change back in September. We also tend to keep songs on rotation a little longer because there are fewer releases in the summer."

The playlist consists of an A list (15 titles aired four-five times daily), a B list (15-20 titles aired two-three times daily) and a C list (four-five titles aired once daily).

To accommodate working with fewer staff during the summer holidays, Dhollander says, "We make some of the programmes longer. For instance, my programme is one hour longer. Also, some of our freelance people's programmes are lengthened from two to four hours."

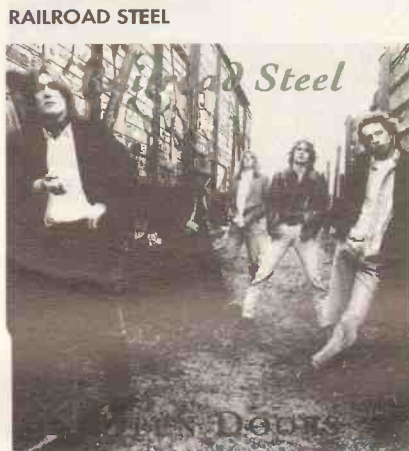

 On a hopping funky bass line **Jay** is scating his vocals, while the horn section exhales full blast. Mind blowingly good stuff!

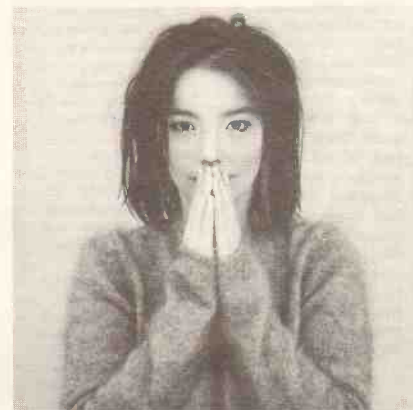
**RAILROAD STEEL**

 The cabinet of eccentric American musicians has a new inhabitant with Bennett, who may take a seat next to rockabilly weirdo **Tav Falco** and loony **Jonathan Richman**. His music is faithful to traditional rock 'n' roll and his lyrics are euphemistically speaking "funny." Only reading titles like *Rich Man's Dog*, *Desert Story* and *Billions And Billions Of Hamburgers Sold* is enough to make you laugh.

**BJÖRK**  
*Debut* - One Little Indian **A/EHR**  
 PRODUCER: Nellee Hooper/Björk  
 Will Iceland's **Björk (Sugar Cubes)** be the next **Sinéad O'Connor**? This solo album successfully marries eccentricity to accessibility. The musical-esque song *Like Someone In Love* and the current single *Human Behaviour* with those thundering timpani are prime examples of this. According to **BRTN 2/Kortrijk**, Belgium producer **Peter de Groot** "It's a bit off the wall but very catchy at the same time and



the single is one of the best things to come along in an otherwise lackluster summer."

**CAVALIERE**  
*Come Un Animale* - K.M.S/Sony **EHR/D/ACE**  
 PRODUCER: Pino Di Pietro/Raphael Scinia  
 Watch out for this knight who combines typical Mediterranean passionate style with an up-to-date production. Even a ballad like *Luce* gets that trendy but tasteful rhythmic injection. However, *Banda Di Raggazzi* is the most "sec" track, presenting Cavaliere unplugged.

**DODGY**  
*The Dodgy Album* - A&M **A/R/EHR**  
 PRODUCER: Ian Broudie  
 Apart from the better sound quality, you would swear to have taken a time capsule to the psychedelic '60s when love was the drug along with some other candies. Pull Paisley trousers from the top shelf, because **Syd Barrett** is back in town. Prepare yourself for another summer of love and be sure to wear a flower in your hair when you play *Lovebirds*.

**THE FLAMING LIPS**  
*Transmissions From The Satellite Heart* - Warner Brothers **A/R**  
 The diffuse sounds may confuse non-album rockers, but with a bit of patience you'll find some hidden treasures. Behind a wall of distorted guitars, there are some really precious melodies like *Pilot Can At The Queer Of God* and *She Don't Use Jelly*, reminiscent of Pink Floyd's immaculate days and Big Star. Nevertheless, use in moderation.

 PRODUCER: F. Lensen/Q. Lizer/D. Bell  
 Scott presents the type of hip hop album that even outsiders can listen to in one go without getting bored. The single *I Need Your Lovin'* and the **Rose Royce** cover *Love Don't Live Here Anymore* are "hip pop" and sure contenders for EHR.

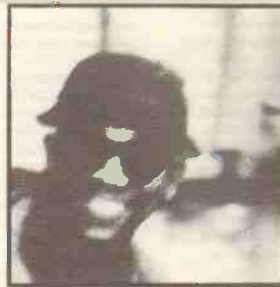

## TELEKOM BERLIN STRIKES AGAIN!

**BFBS Berlin** is none too happy after a special show to be broadcast live from the city's Hard Rock Café was cut off. Says a spokesperson from BFBS, "Someone at Telekom must have pulled out the plugs before the show went on. There was no back-up engineer to sort it out as it was a Sunday, so the whole show was a complete disaster. We weren't able to link up with our studio." Last month both **RTL 104.6** and **Berliner Rundfunk** were complaining that a series of black-outs were due to sabotage by Telekom.

## WHO'S TO BLAME?

One of the most unlikely new recording artists to emerge this year must be **MTV Europe** "News" managing editor and presenter **Steve Blame**. His debut dance single *Give Me Your Love (Je T'Aime)* features busty ex-Army Of Lovers singer **La Camilla** and is released by **BMG Ariola Munich**. The song opens with Blame's sultry enquiry, "Can I Speak To La Camilla?" "Oui c'est moi!" replies the Swedish sexpot. **Blame** is responsible for writing the sexy lyrics and is pictured on the sleeve nuzzling up to the pouting Swedish sex pot in a nice foamy bath. **M&M** asks, what next? La Camilla reading MTV news?

## BRIBERY CHARGES EXTENDED

**Adriano Aragozzini**, organizer of Italy's major musical showcase, the annual San Remo Song Festival, has been re-arrested following additional charges of paying kickbacks to secure rights to the event. Aragozzini was given a four-year suspended sentence in May (**M&M**, June 12) after being found guilty of paying out L870 million (app. US\$540,000) in bribes to local politicians in San Remo in relation to the 1989 festival. Since then he was arrested again on July 8 concerning the 1990 event, in which he is charged with having issued false invoices to fund kick backs to the San Remo major and some councilors.

## VTM ANNOUNCES RADIO PLANS IN FLANDERS

Private Flemish TV station **VTM** has confirmed its plans to launch a radio station in Flanders if changes are introduced in Flemish media law allowing the launch of a "major private radio" in Flanders.

while two-track cassettes were up 39% to 2.3 million units. The vinyl single, which sold 3.1 million units during 1992's first semester, shows negative sales of 56,000 units as retailers are sending their stock back to the record companies.

CDs accounted for the largest part of the surge in June with a 35% increase in value and a 50% increase in units, along with short carriers (CD single and two-track together increased 80%). Vinyl albums and singles moved one step closer to the coffin of outdated carriers, while cassettes only experienced a limited 7% growth in volume. DCC and MiniDisc remain virtually uncharted, with 211 and 388 units, respectively, sold in June.

**Gilles Paire**, president of SNEP and CEO of **PolyGram France**, considers the June growth as "very important" and the global figure for the first semester a "good result." He comments, "It looks like music is

a remedy to the current crisis. Compared to many other sectors, the global trend is positive and I expect we will achieve a 5-6% growth this year."

Paire attributes the June surge to a flow of new superstar releases (**Stephan Eicher**, **Eddy Mitchell**, **Dire Straits**, **Jean-Michel Jarre**) and major events like **Johnny Hallyday's** much-publicised 50th birthday, with its string of related activities (the 40-CD box set and concerts at the Parc des Princes stadium).

"There is no mystery behind these figures," he says. "With major releases and key events, consumers find their way back to stores which in turn boosts the market."

Paire is confident that by the end of the year the trend will continue as other top artists such as **Jean-Jacques Goldman**, **Patrick Bruel** and **Nilda Fernandez** release studio albums; a strong schedule of international releases is also expected (**Prince**, **R.E.M.**).

For Paire, the most positive development shown in these fig-

prevent media concentration.

The bill has been passed, but no one knows how many licences

are to be allocated and how many frequencies are to be made available to private broadcasters, says **Tributsch**. This information will not be known until January 1. Austria is one of the last coun-

tries in Europe to legalise private terrestrial radio. State radio net **ORF** currently has a monopoly on the media scene, with private broadcasters transmitting from across the Austrian borders.

"The names may change everyday, but there's always a place for teenybopper music. Yesterday they were called **Bay City Rollers** or **New Kids On The Block**; today their names are **East 17** or **Take That**. This music has a long tradition, which is the reason why it probably doesn't put off older people.

"Everybody seems to have a weakness for this kind of music, and some songs in the genre grow to be real 'evergreens.' I thought **Take That's** cover of **Barry Manilow's** *Could It Be Magic* [their first simultaneous pan-European release] was a clever move, but now they have managed to write an equally good song themselves. For MOR radio this means safe music with an important sing-along factor which techno lacks. Our listeners won't switch their radio off when **Take That** is on."

The impact of the UK singles chart might be declining, but not for **Z Radio/Stockholm** PD **Tobias Björling**. "We still keep an eye on the UK singles chart because it gives us a good idea of what's on offer at the moment. When a single like *Pray* enters at number 1 in the UK, then we think that's a valid reason to add it. Besides, it's a happy song which fits our format. We have been close to adding a **Take That** single before, but we couldn't avoid this one any longer."

On checking his computer files **Radio Contact N/Brussels** PD **Danny de Bruyn** discovered that his station played *Could It Be Magic* 369 times over a four-month period. "It looks like *Pray* is getting the same treatment because this 'summery' song fits our image of hit radio. In the first

two weeks we played it 27 times, and we'll move on up to three times a day soon. Although competition is tight now, this could become their first top 10 sales hit here. Since the visual aspect is so essential in their concept, TV appearances in Belgium could boost their career. So far they are an accepted sound, but wait and see what happens when they become familiar faces as well."

For most stations, however, *Pray* is the first **Take That** single to get playlisted. Swiss station **Radio Pilatus 104.9/Luzern's** PD **Marcel Caluzi** is another **Take That** first timer. "Middle of the road as we are, this is the right stuff if you don't want to go for techno and restrict hip hop to a minimum. It's interesting to see what will happen now."

**Radio FFH/Frankfurt** head of music **Andreas Karczewski** is positive about the band's future. "New Kids On The Block were suddenly there with a bang and disappeared silently, while **Take That** is in the more steady process of building things up. There isn't the same hysteria. Previous singles like *A Million Love Songs*, for instance, were only played in our romantic night time programme. *Could It Be Magic* and now *Pray* made it to our playlist, but not for such a long time as **New Kids** singles did. They lasted for some 10-14 weeks, as opposed to three to four for **Take That** in this stage. The teen magazines are now picking up this phenomenon, and I predict these guys will survive as long as they carry on making such good singles."

For some stations programming teen music is a dangerous thing, and sometimes even in their home market. **City FM/Liverpool** programme controller **Tony McKenzie** has always tried

to avoid mentioning the band's name when announcing a track in the past. Aiming at the 18-35 demo, he is sceptical about teenyboppers in general, but finally he has been converted for the current single.

*Pray* is also the first **Take That** single **McKenzie** has playlisted. "I know it's great material for the kids, but their choice will change tomorrow. In-house research, however, convinced us that it appealed to a certain part of our listeners. Older women—in the 25-35 age group—are not particularly keen on the band, but they do like this song, which is definitely more adult than anything they have done before. We're not a kid's radio station, and therefore we must be very selective in our choice. It's the first time that **Take That** goes mainstream and for us it's a usable track."

According **BMG Records (UK)** international marketing director **Chrissie Harwood**, the whole project is taking off now. "We've been successful in generating and creating a database system for direct mailing to potential fans everywhere now. Despite all the promo groundwork we've done, sales are now our first concern. The summer with its 'frozen' charts is not the most ideal time to release a single. To show that we're in line with the UK we have released *Pray*, the first single off the second album to be released in September. Nevertheless, we hope to keep that single alive via radio on the continent throughout August and show the results in the charts in September. On the international side, we're still working on the debut album *Take That And Party*. The kids out there might be disappointed when they don't find *Pray* among the tracks, something we have to cope with."

ures is the explosion of CD single, pioneered in Europe on the French market. Paire forecasts that more than 20 million units will be sold by the end of the year. "Even if our margins on this product are low, it is important to have a short format which appeals to those who don't have the means to buy CDs, and which can also be a promotional tool to sell albums."

Paire notes that the share of French product versus international continued to fall in June, although it remained stable for the first half. For the first semester of 1993, international product represented 50% of the sales, national product 41% and classical 9%, compared to 49%, 40% and 11%, respectively, for the first quarter of 1992.

Paire remains optimistic as long as the industry can be asso-

ciated with events like the recent **Francofolies** music festival or the forthcoming "Semaine de la Chanson Française," the week of French music scheduled for February '94 and announced recently by minister of culture **Jacques Toubon**.

Paire also views with interest the evolution of French repertoire on radio stations. "The recent **Mediametrie** polls show that **NRJ** has gained audience while playing a larger share of French music. I hope that it will be giving some ideas to radio program-

mers. If we can deliver good quality French music to radio stations, the trend should reverse."

**Madonna Challenges Joel**

Two Americans are causing the biggest stir in the **EHR Top 40** this week, otherwise marked by the typical stability that goes with the summer holiday season. Whereas last week **Billy Joel** held the **Most Added** status with **Madonna** in second position, this time they have changed places. Madonna leads with 31 additions under her belt; Joel grabs 28 first-time reports. Both artists' current singles are now entering the top 20 during their second charting week, landing right next to each other (Joel at number 19, Madonna at 20) only separated by a slight difference in chart points.

Apart from leading in the **Most Added** category, Madonna's *Rain* also earns the status of fastest moving record of the week (points gain) as well as the biggest chart jump (19 positions). Joel's *The River Of Dreams* climbs up 11 places and classifies as second fastest moving single. Madonna's airplay base is massive in the UK and Ireland (virtually 100% penetration), followed by the Czech Republic, Germany and Sweden (62-67%). German stations alone are responsible for more than 25% of Madonna's adds. Poland, Denmark, Finland and Italy also produce promising figures, with acceptance levels there varying between 25% and 45%.

All in all, Madonna provides serious competition for Joel. The latter, however, can boast achieving a 100% **EHR** penetration in Austria and Switzerland this week, while he manages to continue attracting new playlistings in Denmark, Norway, and Germany. That does not mean, however, that there would be no other contenders for the chart's top spot, still claimed by **UB40** who are now slowly losing ground during their fifth consecutive week of chart reign. **Gabrielle**, **4 Non Blondes**, **Take That** and **Janet Jackson** are all considerably on the rise.

This week's **EHR Top 40** incorporates no more than two new entries; the Minneapolis-based rock band **Soul Asylum** are now surfacing from the underground scene by entering the chart in the lower ranks (though still as highest entry of the week!), thanks to substantial airplay exposure in Norway, Ireland, Poland and the Czech Republic (above 60% penetration in those countries) as well as good initial support in the UK, Germany, Holland, Austria, Russia and Sweden (25-50%).

The other new entry, right at the bottom of the chart, proves that, in the week of his 50th anniversary, one-time rebel **Mick Jagger** is still in radio focus. Germany, Austria, the UK, the Czech Republic, Slovenia and Poland are the best players of *Out Of Focus*, the third single culled from the album *Wandering Spirit*. In Sweden, Norway, Denmark and Belgium, it is kicking off more slowly. *Pieter Kops*
