SYNOPSIS

Featuring a strong cast headed by Ewan McGregor, Tilda Swinton, Peter Mullan and Emily Mortimer, YOUNG ADAM is a moody, sensual thriller that takes place on the canals between Glasgow and Edinburgh during the 1950s.

The film focuses on the crisis of Joe (McGregor); a young drifter who finds work on a barge owned by the down-toearth Les (Mullan) and his enigmatic wife Ella (Swinton). One afternoon Joe and Les happen upon the corpse of a young woman floating in the water and the questions begin. Accident? Suicide? Murder?

As the police investigate the case and a suspect is arrested, it becomes evident that Joe knows more about the drowned woman Cathie (Mortimer) than he will admit. Meanwhile, against the backdrop of the investigation, Joe and Ella embark on a passionate affair.

Written and directed by the award-winning filmmaker David Mackenzie, YOUNG ADAM is adapted from novel by the Scottish Beat writer Alexander Trocchi.

DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

I find characters with human flaws and moral ambiguity interesting. To me, YOUNG ADAM is an amoral moral tale and that's what makes it compelling. The story is about degrees of innocence in a hypocritical moral climate and I was drawn to the project because I saw a chance to explore a kind of moral grey area. Trocchi is pointing a finger at a society which he portrays as a bitter, repressed lynch mob that feeds on a sham morality constructed by the press and eager to equate sex with crime. We're talking about the 1950's here, but the more cynical among us might notice a contemporary parallel. Joe is a man on the run, from himself and from his conscience. He is rebellious, irresponsible and dangerous. But he's also an observant sensualist in a very vulnerable position who is grappling with himself about what to do. He is a character who is about as far from innocent as you can get, but he is also not guilty.

THE LIFE AND WORK OF ALEXANDER TROCCHI

Since his death in 1984, Trocchi has built a cult following and has been cited by many leading writers as a major influence. During the early 1950s, Trocchi edited <u>Merlin</u>, an avant-garde literary magazine based in Paris, which published pieces by Jean-Paul Sartre, Samuel Beckett, and Jean Genet. When it folded in 1955, Trocchi moved to New York, where he wrote YOUNG ADAM. In 1962 Trocchi attended the Edinburgh International Writers' Conference where the Scottish poet Hugh MacDiarmid famously denounced him as "cosmopolitan scum." And in 1965, he hosted the infamous Beat poetry "happening" at the Royal Albert Hall in London. He ended his life as a registered heroin addict in Britain before dying of pneumonia in 1984.

His published novels include: <u>Cain's Book</u>; <u>Helen and Desire</u> (writing as Frances Lengel); <u>Man at Leisure</u>; <u>White</u> <u>Thighs</u>; <u>Young Adam</u>; <u>I, Sappho of Lesbos</u>.

DAVID MACKENZIE (Writer/Director)

Mackenzie has directed a number of award-winning short films for the BBC and Channel Four, including MARCIE'S DOWRY, which was shown in the Critics Week at the Cannes Film Festival 2001. Mackenzie recently completed THE LAST GREAT WILDERNESS, funded by the Scottish Lottery and Trust Films.

JEREMY THOMAS (Producer)

THOMAS produced his first film MAD DOG MORGAN in 1974 in Australia. He then went on to produce Jerzy Skolimowski's THE SHOUT, which won the Grand Prix de Jury at the 1978 Cannes Film Festival. His other credits include three Nicolas Roeg films: BAD TIMING, EUREKA and INSIGNIFICANCE; Julien Temple's THE GREAT ROCK 'N' ROLL SWINDLE; Nagisa Oshima's MERRY CHRISTMAS MR. LAWRENCE; and THE HIT directed by Stephen Frears.

In 1986 he produced Bernardo Bertolucci's THE LAST EMPEROR which swept the 1987 Academy Awards, winning nine Oscars including Best Picture and Best Director.

Thomas' other films include Karel Reisz's EVERYBODY WINS, Bertolucci's THE SHELTERING SKY, LITTLE BUDDHA and STEALING BEAUTY; and David Cronenberg's NAKED LUNCH and CRASH. In 1997 he directed ALL THE LITTLE ANIMALS starring John Hurt and Christian Bale. Most recently he produced Jonathan Glazer's feature debut SEXY BEAST and Bertolucci's THE DREAMERS.

He was Chairman of the British Film Institute from 1992 to 1997 and has been the recipient of numerous awards, including the Michael Balcon British Academy Lifetime Achievement Award. He has been President of the juries at the Tokyo, San Sebastian and Berlin Film Festivals and served on the jury at Cannes in 1987.

DAVID BYRNE (Music)

Byrne is primarily known as one of the co-founders of the group Talking Heads. Acclaimed by both critics and audiences, Talking Heads took popular music in new directions, not only with their sound and lyrics, but also by introducing a visual approach to their work. During his career as a solo artist, Byrne has composed for and collaborated with such artists as Twyla Tharp, Brian Eno and Robert Wilson.

In 1985, the Oscar winning director Jonathan Demme made STOP MAKING SENSE. This highly praised film of the Talking Heads in concert won the National Film Critics Association's prize for best documentary. The following year, Byrne co-wrote and directed the feature film TRUE STORIES. In 1987, he won an Academy Award for co-writing (with Ryuichi Sakamoto and Cong Su) the score for Bertolucci's epic, THE LAST EMPEROR.

Since 2001, Byrne has been touring the US, Europe, Australia and Japan with his 3-piece band and a 6-piece string section from Austin, Texas. Byrne's record label Luaka Bop, was founded in 1988.

GILES NUTTGENS (Director of Photography)

Nuttgens is a well-established director of photography. Prior to working in film, Nuttgens worked on numerous commercials and in television, namely "The Young Indiana Jones Chronicles." He also worked on "Alice in Wonderland" for NBC starring Whoopi Goldberg, Ben Kingsley and Peter Ustinov. His film credits include BANDIT QUEEN, THE DEEP END and most recently SWIMFAN. He also shot second unit on STAR WARS: EPISODES I & II.

COLIN MONIE (Editor)

Monie's credits include THE MAGDELENE SISTERS (winner of the Golden Lion at the Venice Film Festival 2002) and ORPHANS. Monie previously collaborated with David Mackenzie on his short film CALIFORNIA SUNSHINE, which received a Scottish Bafta nomination. He also edited the second series of the television drama "The Cops."

LAURENCE DORMAN (Production Designer)

Dorman's film credits include SILENT CRY, PANDEMONIUM, MILK, PHOTOGRAPHING FAIRIES, YOUNG AMERICANS AND THIS BOY'S STORY (Academy Award winner for Best Foreign Student Film).
